#### 'It's baseless, confusing' TIB on Quader's statement

Transparency International Bangladesh yesterday expressed grave concern regarding Road Transport and Bridges Minister Obaidul Quader's comment on Bangladesh's involvement in peacekeeping missions.

In a statement yesterday, TIB termed the comments "baseless and confusing", and said it allegedly implicated Transparency International (TI) in undermining Bangladesh's involvement in peacekeeping missions.

Such remarks from a politician holding a significant ministerial position not only desperation showcase but also demonstrate a lack of responsibility, the statement reads.

In reference to a recorded statement by the minister, in which he mentioned Iftekharuzzaman, executive director of TIB, expressed his disappointment and said the confusion was caused by state-run BSS and some other news outlets, as they incorrectly, whether implied TIB instead of TI.

Iftekharuzzaman said such instances of mix-ups have happened in the past too, which is unexpected, he added in the statement.




