HC asks BTRC Tk 25,000 to block online gambling ads

The High Court yesterday directed Bangladesh Telecommunication Regulatory Commission to block the online betting or gambling advertisements.

It also ordered the Bangladesh Bank to issue directives to all mobile financial service providers including bKash stop their gateways and channels used to make payments to all betting websites. The HC bench of Justice KM Kamrul Kader and Justice Mohammad Shawkat Ali Chowdhury passed the order following a petition filed by Supreme Court lawyers Miftaul Alam and Sumit Kumar Sarkar.

Odhikar's renewal application was pending with the NGO Affairs Bureau (NGOAB) from 2014 until its deregistration in June 2022. "Odhikar's case reflects the ongoing harassment and targeting of human rights defenders Bangladesh. This practice is precedent a clear violation of the right observance of due process

Ten years after Odhikar published a fact-finding report on extrajudicial killings in Bangladesh, the organisation's Secretary Adilur Rahman the Khan and its director Nasiruddin Elan continue to face "judicial harassment" at the Cyber Tribunal of Dhaka, for allegedly publishing "fake, distorted and defamatory" information.


