



PROF TAHER MURDER Two convicts executed 17 yrs after killing

Two convicts in the Rajshahi University teacher Prof S Taher Ahmed murder case were hanged at Raishahi Central Jail last night.

The executions of Mia Mohammad Mohiuddin and Jahangir Alam were conducted at 10.01pm, Jailer Nizam Uddin told this newspaper.

Putin promises free grain to nations

'Handful of donations' can't replace Black Sea deal, says UN chief

Russian President Vladimir Putin yesterday offered free grain to six poor African countries as he launched a summit with leaders from the continent days after withdrawing from the

Ukraine grain export deal. The two-day summit in Putin's

native Saint Petersburg is being scrutinised as a test of his support in Africa, where he retains support despite international isolation sparked by his military intervention in Ukraine last

In a keynote address at the summit, Putin promised to send grain to six African countries.

"In the coming months we will be able to ensure free supplies of 25,000 to 50,000 tonnes of grain to Burkina Faso, Zimbabwe, Mali, Somalia, Central African Republic and Eritrea," Putin said.

Meanwhile in North Korea, Russia's defence minister accompanied North vulnerable people in middle-income

defence exhibition that featured the North's banned ballistic missiles as the neighbours pledged to boost ties, North Korean state media reported yesterday.

United Nations Secretary-General Antonio Guterres warned that a "handful of donations" won't correct the dramatic impact of the end of a deal that had allowed the safe Black Sea export of Ukraine grain for the past year.

"It is clear that when taking out of the market millions and millions of tonnes of grains it is clear that will lead to higher Guterres prices," reporters. "So, it's not with a handful of donations to

some countries that we

correct this dramatic impact that affects everybody, everywhere.'

While global wheat prices are about half the record high hit in early March 2022 after Russia's invasion, Guterres said any increase now would be "paid by everybody, everywhere - and namely by developing countries and by the Korean leader Kim Jong Un to a and even developed countries."

Forty-two citizens from professions yesterday filed an application with the Supreme Court, seeking permission to place before it their arguments against Jamaat-e-Īslami.


They submitted against Jamaat.

EU to keep the pressure on Myanmar

Says EU special rep Gilmore

The EU will continue to support the Rohingya people for their right to return to their homeland, said Eamon Gilmore, the EU's special representative for

> human rights. will continue "We our pressure on the Myanmar regime," he told reporters after a visit to the Rohingya camp in Cox's Bazar

yesterday. The Myanmar deteriorated after the

military coup and the EU has enforced several rounds of sanctions against the military regime and their supporters, including some of the economic entities in Myanmar.

"We will continue that pressure. We will continue to talk with the other countries about what can be done to bring about the necessary changes in Myanmar so that the Rohingya refugees can return with safety and with dignity to their home and that is the ultimate solution to the problem."

In the meantime, the EU will continue to provide support for the refugees who are in Cox's

"The majority of the population in the camps are young people. Education has a value and it can never be taken away," said Gilmore, who went to Cox's Bazar as part of a five-member EU delegation.

SPOT THE BIRD! ... Hidden behind the grass, this Indian Stone Curlew, otherwise known as the Indian thick-knee, was spotted roaming Padmar Char in Rajshahi. As one can see, these birds are gifted with an appearance fit to camouflage themselves in their habitats – dry areas, including fields, deciduous forests, and dry riverbeds in south and southeast Asian countries. In such places, they also find plenty of food like insects, worms and small reptiles. Indian thick-knees, named after their stout legs and thick knees, are mainly active and make their calls after dark. During the rest of the day, they prefer to remain out of sight. Though they are listed in the "Least Concern" category by the IUCN, Indian thick-knee populations have been seeing a decline throughout the last decade – possibly owing to habitat destruction.
