Today is the 35th death anniversary of Justice Abu Sayeed Chowdhury, former president of Bangladesh.

On the occasion, a qurankhwani and milad mahfil will be held at Nagbari Jame Mosque in Tangail, says a press release.

Justice Chowdhury resigned as vice chancellor of DU on March 15, 1971 protesting killings of two students by Pakistan army.

He later played a significant role in mobilising world opinion for the cause of Bangladesh as special envoy of the provisional government.

In 1985, he was elected chairman of the UN Human Rights Commission. He authored five books, on the Liberation War, law and human rights.



Rail service resumes
on Dhaka-N'ganj
route after 8 months
Fare increases by Tk 5

Rail services between Dhaka and Narayanganj resumed yesterday following an eight-month pause for construction works.

Meanwhile, the fare has been increased by Tk 5. It will now cost Tk 20 for commuter trains.

Kamrul Islam Khan, the station master of Narayanganj railway station, informed that the first commuter train from Kamalapur railway station departed for Narayanganj at 5:00am.

"Local trains operated on this route earlier, when the fare was Tk 15. But from now on, eight commuter trains will run 16 times, offering more passenger facilities," he added.

Passengers welcomed the resumption of train services after the suspension, as it offers a more cost-effective alternative than buses, which charge a minimum Tk 55 fare for commuting from Narayanganj to Dhaka.

However, some passengers expressed concern over the fare increase and urged the authorities to maintain good passenger facilities.

Dhiman Saha Javel, member secretary of Narayanganj passenger rights protection forum, demanded an increase in the number of trains and coaches on this route and insisted on keeping the fare at Tk 15 as before without any increase.

oath taking by 290 Awami League alliance lawmakers has been justified again following the SC order.

Petitioner's lawyer AM Mahbub Uddin Khokon told the SC that oath taking by the 290 lawmakers on January 3, 2019 was unconstitutional as the tenure of the 10th parliament expired on January 28, 2019.

Therefore, there were two parliaments from

January 3 to January 28 in 2019 -- which is unconstitutional, he said.

Attorney General AM Amin Uddin, who represented the state, opposed petition saying that the lawmakers elected for 11th parliament have taken oath (January 3, 2019) and responsibility (January 29, 2019) in accordance with the provisions of articles 72 and 123 of the constitution and there was no breach of the constitution to this effect.

Mentionable, the prime minister had sent gifts to Aman while he was seeking

treatment after he fell sick during the sit-in protest of BNP on Saturday.

Later, Fakhrul held a press conference in the Nayapaltan party office, where he blamed the AL of conspiring against BNP acting chairman Tarique Rahman and his wife Zubaida Rahman ahead of the upcoming elections.

"We fear that plans are being made to falsely charge Tarique and his wife, as well as other BNP senior leaders," he added.

Chancellor M Umar Ali and Dhaka University's Prof Abdur Rab and three freedom fighters.

Citing the application, their lawyer Golam Rahman Bhuiyan told The Daily Star that Jamaat's registration is a settled matter and they have a right to do politics as they had representation in parliament three times.

He said the 47 persons have filed the application voluntarily. Rahman said hearing of the application

On July 27, forty-two eminent citizens filed an application with the SC, seeking its permission to place arguments before it against Jamaat in connection with a pending contempt of court petition.

Following a writ petition, the HC in a landmark verdict on August 1, 2013, declared Jamaat's registration with the EC illegal.

Tarique and Zubaida have been in London since 2008.

This court on November 1 last year issued arrest warrants against the duo.

On June 26 last year, the HC declared Tarique and Zubaida "fugitives" and rejected their petitions challenging the filing of the graft case.

On September 26, 2007,

ACC filed the case with Kafrul Police Station against the two and Zubaida's mother Syeda Iqbal Mand Banu, on charges of amassing assets worth Tk 4.82 crore through illegal means and concealing the information of Tk 2.16 crore in their wealth statements.

However, trial proceedings against Zubaida's mother were cancelled.
