Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday asked people to vote for "boat", the Awami League's electoral symbol, in the next general election so that her party could have another opportunity to serve them.

"People got the country independent by casting votes for 'boat'. The country's development happens only when Awami League is in power," she said.

Addressing a massive rally at Rangpur Zilla School playground, Hasina said she was ready to sacrifice her life like her father for the development of the country, report UNB and BSS.

The AL president had visited Rangpur, the district of her in-laws, in December 2018 during electioneering. Yesterday, she again sought people's support for her party. The premier described measures taken by her

Hasina reached the venue around 3:25pm.

Speaking from a large boat-shaped stage, she said she lost her father, mother, and brothers, and now the people of Bangladesh are her family.

Hasina said whenever the AL comes to power, it improves the condition of farmers, it provides electricity to households, and advances the country.

She asked the crowd, "Will you cast votes for 'boat'? Please show me by raising your hands," The crowd raised SEE PAGE 2 COL 4



A Dhaka court yesterday sentenced BNP acting Tarique Rahman to nine years and his wife Zubaida Rahman to three years in prison in a graft case filed in 2007.



The court found Tarique guilty of illegally earning over Tk 4.82 crore and not mentioning in his wealth statement that he owned assets worth over Tk 4.23 crore. Zubaida was convicted of aiding and

Exports off to a flying start in new fiscal

July's earnings up 15.26pc to \$4.59b

Exports continued their spirited showing into the new fiscal year, bringing home \$4.59 billion

in July, in what can be viewed as a lone bright spark in the economy that has been dogged by fast depleting reserves, narrow fiscal space and slowing industrial activities.

Last month's receipts -- which were up 15.26 percent from a year earlier and \$111.92 million higher than the target -- would somewhat ease the pressure on the dollar stockpile, which stood at \$23.3 billion on July 26.

1 killed as BGB, 'drug traders' clash in Teknaf

A Rohingya man was shot dead and six others sustained bullet injuries during a clash between drug peddlers and Border Guard Bangladesh members in Cox's Bazar's Teknaf.

The clash ensued when BGB members arrested a yaba peddler in the Leda area around 12:00pm, locals said.

BGB said seven of its members sustained injuries. Among them, one has been admitted to hospital with serious

injuries. The deceased Mohammad Rafique, 40, was a resident of "A" block of Leda Rohingya camp under Hnila union, said Mohammad Alam, chairman of the Camp Development Committee of Leda refugee camp.

Zafar Alam is a listed drug peddler.

BGB, in a press release, said a team of border guard arrested a drug peddler Md Zafar Alam with 20,000 yaba tablets around noon.

While the team was returning to base, the cohorts of the drug peddler attacked BGB members. At one point, the miscreants opened fire at the law enforcers in a bid to snatch him, it said.
