Born in 1925 at Runshi village in Jhalakathi, he was involved in leftist politics before starting a career in journalism. Gupta made significant contributions to all democratic movements including the Liberation

He was also jailed several times throughout 12 years for his political connection. He joined journalism in 1957 with the Daily Azad and later switched over to Daily Sangbad.

His post editorial under the pen name "Aniruddha" made him one of the most popular journalists at home and abroad in his time. The ideology behind his writings on politics, economics and the country circulated around objectivity, independence and honesty. His article, analysis, critique politics and economics added a different trend in journalism.

Gupta was awarded Ekushey Padak, Sher-e-Bangla Padak, Maulana Tarkabagish Padak, Jahur Hossain Memorial Padak, Kazi Mahbubullah-Zebunnisa Welfare Trust Award and many more.

To mark his death anniversary, Santosh Gupta Smriti Parishad will place wreaths at his memorial at Postagola crematorium at 9:00am, said a press

wildlife of the area. Following the same proposal, he issued another letter to the conservator of Forests, Wildlife and Nature Reserve on February 27 last year, providing a rationale for reducing the speed of trains.

Meanwhile. another letter was sent from the forest ministry to the railways ministry, urging them to take necessary measures in this regard.

On January 29, a letter signed by Taufiq Imam, deputy secretary (additional duties) of the railways ministry was sent to railway director general, instructing him to take necessary measures to keep the speed limit of all the trains running on the existing railway within 20km.

Sreemangal stationmaster Shakhawat Hossain said the forest department has given a letter regarding the speed limit, but they have not received it from the authorities yet.

Railway officials, seeking anonymity, said as the area has small slopes and hills, the train will not be able to ply up the slopes if the speed is so low.

On March 3, 2022. the wildlife department organised a campaign to limit vehicle speed.

However, movement within the forest still continues at high speed, putting wild animals at risk.

Sohel Shyam, one of the founders of Stand for Our Endangered Wildlife, a voluntary organisation, said, if the 20km per hour speed limit is maintained, many animals will be saved.
