submit nomination papers online. While the EC encourages candidates to file nomination papers online, it is not yet possible to make it mandatory, Jahangir said.

Meanwhile, during the meeting, the ECs turned down a proposal to form a committee to prepare a draft list of presiding officers, assistant presiding officers, and polling officers.

A meeting source said that EC officials presented a draft policy with provisions for having a committee at the upazila level with the upazila nirbahi officer (UNO) as convener and a committee at the district level with the deputy commissioner as convener that will prepare draft lists of polling officials.

"At the meeting, there were disagreement on the draft list of polling officials, but no decision was taken regarding the matter," said Jahangir.

of cropland and trees in Khitabkhan, Gatiasham villages of Gharialdanga union and Chatura, Ramhari and Kalirhat villages of Bidyananda union, said locals.

Meanwhile, thousands of houses in five villages of Bidyananda and Gharialdanga unions of the upazila - Kalirhat Bazar, Burihat Bazar, Kalirhat Government Primary School, Khitabkhan Government Primary School, Char Khitabkhan Government Primary School, Gatiasham Community Clinic and four mosques, two temples, various structures and hundreds of acres of cropland are facing erosion threat.

Abdus Sattar, 80, who lost home due to river erosion in Khitab Khan village, said: "We do not expect relief, we demand the government to implement the Teesta Master Plan to stop the erosion by the river."

Echoing the same, local UP member Mamun Mandal said, "He said the education of 300 to 400 students of Khitab Khan Government Primary School will be uncertain if it is washed away by the river."

Abdullah Al Mamun, executive engineer of Kurigram Water Development Board, said the work of dumping sand bags is going on at some places of Gharialdanga and Bidyananda unions to prevent erosion.

keeps track of how Mamun's family is surviving.

Now, after 19 years, both Mridha and Morsheda want to witness the execution of the October 10, 2018 verdict in which 19 people were sentenced to death and another 19 people to life term imprisonment.

"The killers responsible for my son's untimely end have faced trial, yet the judgment remains unrealised. We want to see my son's killers get their dues within our lifetimes," expressed Morsheda.

The victim, Phulpori, was tortured and intimidated by the accused in Sheikh Hasina Hall on February 12 night, where she was forced to get undressed while the accused recorded the scene. The accused also threatened to kill her if she shared the incident with anyone.

Following the incident, on February 14, she submitted a complaint to the university proctor, student adviser and the hall provost, demanding punishment of those involved in torturing her. Three separate committees were formed to investigate the incident that time.

## Relocation riddle yet

Economic Council (Ecneec) approved a Tk 206 crore project to construct modern markets in Mohakhali, Amin Bazar, and Jatrabari areas, aiming to improve the supply system for farm products and reduce traffic congestion in Karwan Bazar.

The project was suspended until 2013 and resumed with a revised budget of Tk 264 crore.

In the meantime, the Mohakhali kitchen market was later transformed into a Covid-19 dedicated hospital during the pandemic. At present, the hospital is being used to treat dengue patients. DNCC has plans to turn it into a full-fledged general hospital in future, said DNCC Spokesperson Mokbul Hossain.

Currently, DNCC owns four markets at Karwan Bazar with 1,789 permanent and 180 temporary shops on around 24 bighas of land. Of these, 814 permanent and 180 temporary shops are planned to be relocated to Amin Bazar, spread across 13 acres of land, and housing 1,165 shops, according to Mutakabbir.

Similarly, the Jatrabari wholesale kitchen market will have 912 shops, accommodating 895 shops from Karwan Bazar on 5.21 acres of land.

The construction work for both Amin Bazar and Jatrabari is already 90 percent complete, he added.

Visiting the Jatrabari and Amin Bazar markets recently, this correspondent found the five-storey complexes have been constructed with the structure of shops inside.

Prof Adil Mohammed Khan, executive director at the Institute for Planning and Development (IPD), cited various issues regarding the relocation including a lack of trust and cooperation between the authorities concerned and stakeholders.

He also said the inappropriate design of the newly-constructed markets in the designated places is a matter of concern.

Prof Adil suggested that authorities modify the market designs based on traders' demands and ensure necessary construction and renovations.

DNCC Mayor Md Atiqul Islam said, "It is not a feasible option to maintain the Karwan Bazar wholesale market in the heart of the capital. It is imperative for the businesses to vacate the area as per Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's decision."

In response to the traders' demands for three separate roads at Amin Bazar and Jatrabari, Atiqul said they are currently in communication with their engineering offices.

"If there is sufficient space available in the two designated areas, they will proceed with constructing the additional roads," he said.
