TEA WORKERS IN HABIGANJ A month-long strike for arrears, better life

Around 360 tea workers and their families of Imam and Bawani tea gardens in Habiganj's Nabiganj upazila have observed a strike for a month to press home their sevenpoint demand that include receiving due wages and better living conditions.

The tea workers have long been holding various programmes demanding rations, unpaid wages, bonuses and festival allowances, arrears of provident fund, medical care, and permanent accommodation, but to no avail.

Although tea garden owners repeatedly assured them of meeting their demands, they have yet to come up with any visible steps to this end, tea workers alleged, adding that they no longer have faith in mere words of affirmation.

Talking to this correspondent, the workers claimed the owners are not paying their dues, violating the labour contract signed between the Bangladesh Tea Association and the Bangladesh Tea Workers' Union.

On June 25, the tea workers wrote to the chairman and managing director of Imam Tea Estate Ltd to realise their demands. However, as the owners did not take the complaints into consideration, the tea workers went on strike from July 3 to July 11.


Rambhajan Rabidas, president of Imam Tea Garden Panchayet Committee, said the owners of Imam and Bawani tea gardens owe Tk 81.59 lakh in outstanding wages and Tk 14.47 lakh in bonuses, which was to be paid to 360 workers in the financial years 2019-20 and 2021-

Besides, retired workers are also not getting their matured provident fund.

Also, the tea workers have long been suffering due to poor accommodation and are also being deprived of medical services due to a lack of doctors at the gardens.

Under these circumstances, the tea workers resorted to continuous strikes from July 21 to August 22, demanding

WATERLOGGING IN BHALUKA Students suffer due to unplanned constructions

A high school in Mymensingh's Bhaluka upazila remains under water during the monsoon due to unplanned construction of buildings in the neighbourhood. A little rainfall inundates field of the Batajhor Bhawal Muslim High School field for several days, hampering academic activities.

During a recent visit to the school, this correspondent saw the teachers and students have to wade through ankle to knee-deep water in the field to reach

Though waterlogging has been a problem for the last 10 years, the situation took a serious turn in last 2 years, said Md Abdul Quddus, the headmaster of

"Now we face severe waterlogging for around four months every year. During heavy showers, the field remains inundated for some 10 days," said the

There are some 1,400 students in the school, but only 200 attend their classes during the monsoon, he added.

Locals say markets and buildings have been built blocking canals which used to drain out rainwater.

The school authority and local people have knocked the doors of administration and local leaders seeking relief from this menace, but found no SEE PAGE 4 COL 4

A delegation led by Saudi Minister for Hajj and Umrah Dr Tawfiq Al-Rabiah was scheduled to arrive at Dhaka, on a three-day visit, last night, Md A Hamid Zamadder, Secretary of religious affairs ministry told The Daily Star.

The purpose of the delegation's visit is to advance Saudi Arabia's initiatives aimed at enhancing the pilgrimage experience for Bangladeshis during Hajj and Umrah.

The Nusuk roadshow by Saudi Tourism Authority will be launched tomorrow at the Bangabandhu International Convention Centre in the capital, sources at the religious affairs ministry said. Additionally, the Nusuk digital platform for Umrah pilgrims will also be launched tomorrow.

This comment came against the backdrop of BNP leaders' claims that top officials of law enforcement agencies are making political statements ahead of the upcoming general

The IGP made the remark while visiting Habiganj Police Station Officer-in-Charge Ajay Chandra Dev at the National Eye Science Institute and Hospital in Dhaka.

Ajay's eye got injured in a clash between BNP and police during a BNP road march in Habiganj on Saturday when a brick chunk hit him.

Responding to a query, Mamun said, "I have not come across any statement from law enforcement agencies that can be deemed political. We fulfill our duties according to the law and regulations."
