with 1 (one) imprisonment or a fine not exceeding Tk 20,000 or both. It said if a citizen is knowingly avail more than one NID shall be deemed to have committed an offence under this law and for such crime that person shall be punished with imprisonment of not less than one year or not more than Tk 20,000 or both.

It is considered a criminal offence under the law for anyone involved the registration process, including the preparation, distribution, maintenance national identity cards, to intentionally deface or destroy any information related to the cards kept by the Registrar. The punishment for such an offence is imprisonment for up to seven years, a fine of up to Tk 1 lakh, or both.

Any person who distorts or destroys any information mentioned in the National Identity Card for dishonest purposes shall be deemed to have committed an offence under this Act and shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 2 (two) years or to a fine not exceeding 40 (forty) thousand or to both.

Any person who makes unauthorised access to data or uses data illegally shall be deemed to have committed an offence under this law and for such offence shall be punished with imprisonment for a term not exceeding 5 (five) years or with a fine not exceeding Tk 50,000 or with both.

Each dredger can extract 250-300 cubic metres of stone in an hour, and the in the upazila. We have owners can earn a good profit share by working with the stone extractors. Each operator is paid around Tk 800 per day, said Khabir Uddin, a dredger machine operator in Kawamari village.

"Fearing mobile courts, some owners operate dredgers at night to lift stones from the rivers," he added.


