

US university fair held in Chattogram

The number of Bangladeshi students enrolling in colleges and universities in the United States is increasing and the US wants this number to grow more to strengthen and develop ties between the two countries, said an official of the US embassy here in Chattogram yesterday.

Stephen F Ibelli, public affairs counselor of the US embassy, said, "Last year we saw a 23 percent jump in the number of students from Bangladesh attending colleges in the US."

Around 11000 Bangladeshi students went to the US last year to get enrolled in the American college and universities, he said.

Ibelli was addressing at US University Fair held at Radisson Blu Chattogram Bay View.

The fair was organised by the US embassy in Bangladesh, through its Education USA platform.

A total of 24 colleges and universities from all over the United States took part at the fair displaying their courses at different stalls.

Huge number of interested graduate and under graduate students attended the fair.

According to Embassy officials the number of Bangladeshi students in the United States has more than tripled in the past decade.

They said in the 2011-2012 academic year, there were 3,314 Bangladeshi students in the United States, while the number increased to 10,597 in 2021-2022 academic year.

Minister Sheikh Hasina sheltered 1.2 million forcibly displaced people from Myanmar on humanitarian grounds. However, even in the seventh year of the crisis, there is no solution in sight whereas Bangladesh is pushed to the limits.

The president said Bangladesh wishes to enhance its relations with Asean and institutionalise it by becoming Asean's Sectoral Dialogue Partner.

"There are many sectors including trade, investment, trans-national security issues, and climate change where Asean and Bangladesh can

cooperate," he added.

Saying that the Indian Ocean Rim Association (IORA) has evolved into an important regional forum on shared values and mutual cooperation, he said it has provided a platform for cooperation in six priority areas and two cross-cutting issues with further possibilities.

"The region - linked by commerce for centuries - is still at the centre of global trade and investment flows. IORA can reap benefits from most of the emerging connectivity options and Asean is on top of this list," he added.

He said he is elated to see the institutionalisation of co-operation between Asean and IORA and warmly welcomed the newly signed MoU between them.

IORA's engagement in the Indo-Pacific region would ensure a fair, equitable and sustainable trade and investment environment that would enhance economic growth and cooperation while building resilient regional and global value chains, he hoped.

For private schools, academic accreditation will be valid for three years, and registration for one year, with the possibility of renewal if conditions are met, he said, adding that the government will issue specific guidelines in this regard soon.

"Currently, only 10 percent of schools are registered, while the remaining 90 percent operate without proper registration. These educational institutions will be granted a three-month period to complete their

registration," said Farid. Emphasising the need for 100 percent literacy, Zakir Hossain, state minister for primary and mass education, said, the literacy rate was 76.8 percent, among the population aged seven and above as per Bangladesh Sample Vital Statistics 2022.

"Achieving development goals require raising the literacy rate of the remaining 23.2 percent of the population," he added.

At the event, the state minister was also asked about the establishment of a second Primary Teacher

Training Institute (PTI), in his hometown Roumari upazila of Kurigram, despite a PTI already being present in the district.

A significant number of discussions had previously surfaced in this regard as some of the state minister's relatives were said to be allegedly benefitting from the land acquisition process in this project, according to various media reports.

Denying the allegations of personal benefits, Zakir said his initiative aims to benefit only the teachers in the char areas by ensuring training facilities near

their homesteads instead of having to travel to Kurigram or Mymensingh for the facilities.

"My family does not own any land in the area, but some of my distant relatives do. Their land was acquired for this project. The original price of the acquired land is three times the government's acquisition rate," he added.

Currently, there are 67 PTIs located throughout the country, serving the training needs of primary teachers under the Ministry of Primary and Mass Education.
