Hilsa production booming in Khulna

UNB, Khulna

Hilsa production in Khulna has increased by almost 22 times, in the last 15 years, thanks to various steps taken by the district fisheries office.

Production of shrimp, fish -- including carp, catfish, crab, kuchia -- and dried fish also increased during this period, said experts.

According to sources at Khulna District Fisheries Office, the production of hilsa has increased because of effective steps taken by the government over the last 15 years. As a result, the district is playing an important role in supplying fish all over the country, after meeting the demands in the locality.

Sources said 115 tonnes of hilsa was produced in 2006-2007 fiscal years, but now the number stands at 2,555 tonnes in the 2022-23 fiscal years.

Khulna District Fisheries Office claim that fish production has increased resulting from implementation of mother hilsa and jatka conservation programmes.

The government also took steps to keep fishing at a tolerable level during Covid-19. During the pandemic, the government provided Tk 14,79,45,000 to 9,863 affected fishermen, which played an important role in increasing hilsa production.

Besides, the production of shrimp was 18,255 tonnes 15 years ago, while it now stands at 25,375 tonnes in the current fiscal year. Similarly, production of carp was 66,265 tonnes during the fiscal year of 2006-07 and is now at 1,21,750 tonnes in 2022-23 fiscal year.

Additionally, to increase production of shrimp, the government introduced a cluster system, with 94 clusters already set up in Khulna district for financial assistance.

Meanwhile, every year, the government imposes a twomonth ban on fishing in the Bay of Bengal, from May 20 to July 23, to ensure smooth breeding of fish, which is also an effective measure to boost fish production.

Joydeb Pal, district fisheries officer, said the government has taken steps for the development of the fisheries sector and the pilot project in shrimp cultivation is gaining popularity.

University student, another lose lives in road accident

Two individuals have lost their lives, and three others sustained injuries in a tragic incident where a bus collided with a CNG-run autorickshaw in Tebunia farm area of Pabna Sadar upazila yesterday

The accident occurred on the Pabna-Ishwardi highway when a bus collided with the autorickshaw. Jahangir Hossain, sub-inspector of Pakshi Highway Police Station, confirmed that the collision resulted in the immediate death of the two.

The deceased were identified as Rifat Al Sifat, 21, from the Juna Ramchandrapur area in Sujanagar upazila, and Rumman, 20, from Mohela area in Chatmohar upazila, as confirmed by the officer.

Sifat was a student in the economics department at Khulna University. The injured individuals were admitted to Pabna General Hospital for medical treatment. Following the incident, the bus was seized, but its driver and helper fled the scene, according to SI Jahangir.

Woman found dead at house

A 53-year-old woman was found dead at her house at Paschim Tutpara Farid Molla intersection in Khulna city on Wednesday.

Getting no response from Anima after repeated phone calls, Subhendu's sister informed him. Later, Subhendu went to the house and found

her dead on her bed. Police suspected that miscreants killed her
