Aman and his wife Sabera for acquiring illegal wealth.

On June 21 that year, Aman was sentenced to 13 years' imprisonment while Sabera was sentenced to three years in jail.

On September 3 this year, Sabera was sent to prison after she surrendered before a Dhaka court. However, on September 5, the SC chamber judge granted her a bail till January 15, 2024.

The same court sent Aman to jail on September 10, rejecting his bail plea, after he surrendered before it. Senior lawyer Khurshid Alam Khan appeared for the ACC during the hearing.

In contrast, 46 percent respondents said they faced no struggle to eat in the past year, according to the study.

The survey said 58 percent – majorities in 22 out of the 30 countries polled – are worried that political unrest in their countries could lead to violence in the next year. In Bangladesh, that figure rises to 70 percent.

It also revealed that 84 percent respondents think lending countries should help those struggling with debt by cancelling, reducing, or renegotiating repayment conditions.

Meanwhile, 75 percent want high-income countries to increase overseas aid, and 71 percent believe they should compensate low-income countries for economic losses due to climate change.

In Bangladesh, 88 percent of respondents agreed that high-income countries should take the lead on compensating low-income ones for economic losses caused by climate change.

Respondents consider climate change a major concern alongside poverty and inequality,, with 70 percent being anxious that it will affect their lives next year.

Corruption is seen as the biggest national problem across the world. In Bangladesh, 62 percent

respondents said they trust national politicians to work in their best interests.

According to the study, migration is highly visible but of low concern. In Bangladesh, which is the second largest refugee-hosting country in the world, 83 percent respondents believe countries should open up more safe and legal routes for refugees. The figure falls to 58, 55, and 39 percent in the US, UK and Germany respectively.

In Bangladesh, 85 percent agree that lower-income countries should have more of a say in global decision-making, but the figure drops gradually to 68, 50, 49, 45, 33, and 29 percent in India, China, the US, the UK, Germany, Japan and Russia respectively.

Financial Service (MFS) data, National ID (NID) numbers, and residential addresses, said the DB officer.

These two critical components – stolen fingerprints and gathered personal data – were then systematically combined and packaged for sale on various social media platforms, he explained.

Junaed said the arrestees used to activate at least 100 SIM cards daily and they had been doing it for a year.

"Primary evidence suggests that they had established a robust network across the country," the police official said.

Based on a tip-off, the

arrestees – SR of a mobile operator Md Masud, 22, his assistant Imon Hossain (25), Sohul Rana (36), Md Shakil (25), customer care employee Al Amin Mia (26), and his brother Arafat Rahman (23), and their associates Mehedi Hasan (24) and Nure Alam (24) – were arrested from Dhaka, Rangpur, and Kurigram on Monday.

Detectives recovered 800 individuals' fingerprint details, 110 activated SIM cards, a glue gun, two computers, three finger scanners, and an app used for collecting personal details.

Junaed further said that the SIM operators must take responsibility for these crimes, as their employees are involved in them.

Obaidul Quader and BNP Secretary General Mirza Fakhru Islam Alamgir have highlighted the fear of communal violence ahead of the upcoming elections.

"Their fear is not unfounded. Incidents of attacks on minorities tend to escalate during election

periods," he said.

Dasgupta lamented the lack of progress in implementing the promises outlined in the ruling party's election manifesto, including the establishment of the Minority Protection Act and the National Commission for Minority Affairs.

Akter Mahmud blamed government officials for failing to improve the capital's traffic management by overly focusing on toll-based flyovers and expressways.

He pointed out the expressway has increased congestion on key roads during peak hours.

Addressing the event, Afsana Haque, a communications expert, said the expressway could seriously impact Dhaka if it does not integrate affordable public transport for all classes.

She also talked about potential bottlenecks at expressway ramp points in already crowded areas like Banani and Indira Road.

IPD Executive Director Adil Khan said redesigning the expressway to integrate it with city bus services could make it more useful.

IPD Director Ariful Islam, transport expert Nurul Hassan, JU Professor Farhadur Reza, and Work for a Better Bangladesh Trust's Director Gaous Pearee also spoke at the event.

while being taken to hospital due to delay in crossing the river, he said.

Ratan Haldar, a trader, said they have to pay Tk 1,000-1,500 more per truck to bring goods, due to the absence of a concrete bridge.

"Many traders, like me, have to face financial loss due to a lack of a bridge," he said.

Mukti Biswas, a class 4 student of Mulia Secondary School, said, "Every day we have to cross the river with a lot of difficulties. It is a waste of time for hundreds of students like me as we have to wait on the banks

of the river for two to three hours."

Rabindranath Roy, chairman of Mulia Union, said some 8,000-10,000 people cross the river every day and 60,000 people in 15-20 villages around the river are deprived of a concrete bridge over the Kajla river. He also demanded a concrete bridge there.

Biswajit Kumar Kundu, executive engineer of Narail Local Government and Rural Development (LGED), said there is a plan to build a 400-metre long bridge over the river and the construction work of the bridge will begin soon after getting approval.
