the accused individuals to surrender before the lower court concerned within eight weeks.

The bench comprising Justice Md Jahangir Hossain and Justice Mohammad Showkat Ali Chowdhury issued the order following a petition filed by the accused lawyers seeking anticipatory bail from the court.

Earlier in the day, the petitioners appeared before the High Court bench with their bail petition.

The case was filed with Kotwali Police Station in the capital against 66 people on the charge of attacking police in front of the Dhaka Metropolitan Sessions Judges' Court on September 12.

Reportedly, at least 23 people were injured during

a clash between pro-BNP lawyers and the police in the area.

The clash erupted when the BNP-backed lawyers organised a procession on Johnson Road, defying restrictions.

According to both police and BNP sources, seven law enforcement officers and 16 pro-BNP lawyers were wounded during the confrontation.

Among those granted anticipatory bail yesterday are BNP Joint Secretary General AM Mahbub Uddin Khokon and its Law Secretary Kayser Kamal, AKM Ehasnur Rahman, their lawyer, told The Daily Star.

Senior lawyer Zainul Abedin presented arguments on behalf of the accused lawyers during the hearing of the bail petition.

the patients and their attendees.

Among the critical patients in the ICU was one Lima Akhter, a 35-year-old housewife from Mirpur.

Miraj Hawaladar, her nephew, said doctors at Mirpur General Hospital referred Lima to the dedicated dengue facility after her condition deteriorated. "My aunt was in the Mirpur hospital for three days. She has been in the ICU since last night," he said.

Lucky Akhter from Manikganj, another ICU patient, initially spent two days at a local hospital before being referred to the Mohakhali facility, said her nephew Sumon. "Her situation is improving although she isn't out of danger yet," he added.

Md Alamgir from Gazipur is yet another

critical patient in the ICU, whose deteriorating condition prompted his transfer from Gazipur Chandina Hospital after a three-day stay.

"His platelet count was getting dangerously low. Then we were advised to move him to Dhaka from the local hospital. So, we did. But he's still not out of danger," said his younger sister Panna.

Contacted, Colonel Dr AKM Hossain Khan, acting director of the hospital, said the number of dengue patients are rising this month. "Mainly critical patients with platelet deficiency, shock syndrome, and low blood pressure are being referred here."

"We have a sufficient number of staffers. If needed, the number of beds will be increased," he added.

Mary Aileen Diez-Bacalso, executive director of FORUM-ASIA, said in the statement, "This conviction, coinciding with the 25th anniversary of the UN Declaration of Human Rights Defenders, symbolises a blatant attempt to stifle dissent, undermine fundamental freedoms of expression and association, and criminalise the vital work undertaken by human rights defenders. These actions starkly contradict the core principles of democracy and the rule of law."

The government has

taken initiatives to limit the spread of mosquito-borne diseases, they added.

There is no vaccine or drug that specifically treats dengue, which is common

in South Asia during the June to September monsoon season when the Aedes aegypti mosquito, the carrier of the deadly virus, thrives in stagnant water.
