JAB AT CHINA Biden recognises two Pacific nations

President Joe Biden said the United States officially recognised the Pacific nations of Cook Islands and Niue vesterday, as he hosted regional leaders in a bid to wrest influence from China.

The announcement came at the start of a summit with the 18-member Pacific Islands Forum, where US officials said the president was announcing a assertive American stance in the region.

Biden said in statements Washington recognised the Cook Islands and Niue as "sovereign and independent" states and would establish diplomatic relations with both.



The move would help maintain a "free and open Indo-Pacific region," said Biden.

Biden added that the deals to recognise the two nations would also help curb illegal fishing, deal with climate change in a vulnerable region and boost economic growth.

The Cook Islands and Niue together have fewer than 20,000 inhabitants but constitute a sprawling economic zone in the South Pacific. Both are self-governing nations in "free association" with New Zealand.

After decades of being treated as a relative backwater, South Pacific has become an important arena for competition between the US and China.

Russian strike damages Odesa port infrastructure

Ukraine says Russian Black Sea fleet commander killed in attack

An overnight Russian air strike on the southern Ukrainian region of Odesa caused "significant damage" to port infrastructure and destroyed some grain storage facilities, Ukrainian officials said yesterday.

No deaths were reported in the attack on Odesa, but at least one person was killed in a separate Russian air strike on the town of Beryslav in the southern region of Kherson region, regional governor Oleksandr Prokudin said.

"Another massive attack on Odesa! ... The attack resulted in the destruction of grain storage facilities and significant damage to the seaport," Economy Minister Svyrydenko, economy minister, said on X.

Russia's defence ministry also reported Ukrainian attacks overnight, saying drones were shot down over the northwestern part of the Black Sea, over Crimea, and over the Russian regions of Kursk and Belgorod regions. It mentioned no deaths.

The Russian attack on Odesa was the latest in a series of missile and drone strikes which Kyiv says are intended to prevent Ukraine, a major grain producer and exporter, shipping its agricultural products to the world.

Ukrainian air defences destroyed 19 Iranian-made Shahed drones and 11 cruise missiles overnight, the vast majority of them were directed at the Odesa region, the military said.

Missing Pak journo turned promoter of Imran returns home

A prominent Pakistani TV journalist turned promoter of jailed former Prime Minister Imran Khan's political party returned home yesterday, police and his lawyer said, giving no indication of where he had been since he disappeared in May.

A court last week gave the police until September 26 to recover Imran Riaz, a social media influencer popular with Khan's followers, or face legal action.

Police had told the court he was not in their custody or being held by intelligence agencies. Riaz, who has more than five million followers on X, formerly known as Twitter, had taken on the Pakistani military and its intelligence agencies after Khan was removed from power in April 2022 and blamed the army for his ouster.

The latest criticism by Riaz of the military included serious accusations made without producing evidence.

Local police have said they detained him in the eastern city of Sialkot on May 11, two days after Khan's supporters attacked military installations as the former leader was arrested.

INDIA-CANADA ROW

Punjab's Sikhs fear backlash from diplomatic spat

A bitter row between India and Canada over the murder of a Sikh separatist is being felt in Punjab, where some Sikhs fear both a backlash from India's Hindu-nationalist government and a threat to their prospects for a better life in North America.

Hardeep Singh Nijjar, a plumber who left the north Indian state a quarter-century ago and became a Canadian citizen, was shot dead in June outside a temple in a Vancouver suburb where he was a separatist leader among the many Sikhs living there.

Canadian PM Justin Trudeau said last week Ottawa had "credible allegations" that Indian government agents may be linked to the killing.

In the village of Bharsinghpura, Hardeep's uncle, Himmat Singh Nijjar, 79, said locals "think it was very brave of Trudeau" to accuse Prime Minister Narendra Modi's government of potential involvement in the killing. The elder Nijjar said he is worried about deteriorating relations with Canada and declining economic prospects in Punjab.

Philippines removes Chinese barrier

The Philippines said yesterday it executed a "special operation" to remove a floating barrier installed by China at a prime fishing patch in the South China Sea, a move that could stoke tension after a years-long detente in Asia's most disputed waters. The Philippines expressed outrage on Sunday and


