A journey by train with PM



Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina inaugurated the 82km railway track from Dhaka to Faridpur's Bhanga upazila under the Padma Bridge Rail Link Construction vesterday During her train ride to Faridpur, at least

50 individuals of various backgrounds and ages accompanied the PM.

They included freedom fighters, vendors, traders, RMG workers, drivers, farmers, and students.

There were also people from diverse religious backgrounds, and members of indigenous communities. enforcement officials, armed forces personnel, along with members of the fire service, scout, and BNCC were also present. The premier, along with her family

members, boarded the train by waving a green flag at 12:55pm.

She spoke to her co-passengers in the special train containing 14 coaches that was heading to Bhanga from Mawa.

Talking about the train journey alongside the prime minister, freedom fighter Aminur Rahman Farid said, "I can't articulate this feeling. I can't believe I was

Courts hamstrung by judge crisis

The Appellate Division of the Supreme Court has been facing an acute shortage of judges, as no new one was appointed after December 8 last year

Meanwhile, three judges including a chief justice have retired in the last 10 months.

Each of the Appellate Division judges including Chief Justice Obaidul Hassan is burdened with around 3,750 cases on an average as around 22,500 cases are pending with this court, SC sources said.

The number of apex court judges has come $down \ to \ six \ from \ 11 in \ 2009 \ after \ appointments$ and retirements of some judges.

In the last 10 months, Chief Justice Hasan Foez Siddique retired on September 25, Justice Md Nuruzzaman retired on June 30 and Justice Muhammad Imman Ali on December 31 last year.

On July 9, 2009, the then president raised the number of judges at the Appellate Division from seven to 11, prior to disposing of some important cases, including those centring the SEE PAGE 4 COL 3

Man held with 1kg crystal meth

Dhaka Metropolitan Police yesterday claimed to have arrested a drug dealer with one kg of crystal meth, or "ice" in Abdullahpur area of Uttara.

The arrestee, Iftekhar Uddin Shakib, 24, was arrested in front of Polwel Carnation Shopping Centre around 11:00am.

Iftekhar moved to Uttara around six months ago, Mohammad Morshed Alam, deputy commissioner of Uttara division of DMP, said while addressing a briefing. Police arrested Iftekhar based on information

that a big narcotics consignment was entering the capital. Police recovered the crystal meth wrapped inside a polythene bag from Iftekhar's possession, DC Morshed said.

"Primary investigation revealed that Iftekhar, hailing from Teknaf, ran a drug peddling gang. He collected narcotics from a drug dealer and sold them to different areas of Dhaka," he said.

They used Facebook messenger to take orders and delivered the drugs inside Mobil cartons. A case was filed in this regard.

Dengue death toll crosses 1,100

At least 13 more people died from dengue in 24 hours preceding 8:00am yesterday, as the country grapples with a record outbreak of the mosquitoborne disease. Of the 13 deaths, nine were reported in the capital.

At least 2,555 dengue patients were hospitalised in the 24-hour period, according to data from the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS).

Dengue has so far claimed at least 1,109 lives this year and nearly 2,28,779 were infected, making this the deadliest year since the first recorded epidemic in 2000.
