Niko cases filed to implement 'minus two' formula

Khaleda's lawyer tells HC

BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia's lawyer AJ Mohammad Ali yesterday told the High Court that the Niko cases were filed in order to implement the "minus two"

The "minus two" formula had aimed to exclude Awami League President and now Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina and BNP chief Khaleda Zia from politics during the last military-backed caretaker government.

"Two separate cases were filed in 2007 against Sheikh Hasina and Khaleda Zia over an unsolicited offer from Canadian company Niko. The High Court has quashed the proceedings of the case against Sheikh Hasina and no appeal was filed against its verdict. The case against Khaleda Zia, however, is still running," advocate AJ

The lawyer said this before the HC bench of Justice Md Nazrul Islam Talukder and Justice Khizir Hayat Lizu yesterday during hearing of a petition filed by Khaleda. The petition challenged the legality of the trial court order that allowed the investigation officer and prosecution witness of the case to place deposition on seeing the first information report.

In the petition, Khaleda said the trial court order is a direct violation of section 159 of the Evidence Act and prayed to the HC to stay the trial proceedings of the case against her.

The HC bench fixed 2:00pm today for resuming the hearing.

Hospitals still grappling with large number of patients; 9 more die, 2,609 hospitalised in a day

Jamal Hossain was having a -- Yasin, 8, and Fatima, 10, -- had started feeling better yesterday afternoon, four days after they were both admitted to Mugda Medical College Hospital with dengue.

The children were talking each other with their beds brought together upon permission to make it easy for their father to look after them.

"Both my children were diagnosed with dengue around four days ago. They were hospitalised on Sunday after suffering from severe diarrhoea and vomiting. However, they are now feeling better," said Jamal, a resident of Jurain's Boubazar area.

This year, 11,886 dengue patients were admitted to this hospital -the highest among all hospitals countrywide -- among whom 133 lost their lives.

Though the number of daily dengue patients has declined, new patients are still coming here on a regular basis. The hospital is currently treating 168 dengue patients.

2,609 were hospitalised in the last 24 hours till yesterday morning.

Laiju Begum, a resident of Madhya Badda, shared similar distress.

"About 40 days ago, we admitted my eight-year-old daughter Rita Aktar to a private clinic after she tested positive for dengue. She had recovered completely after a while. However, we had to rush her here as she had been suffering from fever for the past week," said Laiju.

Asked what was wrong with Rita, Laiju said the doctors here have prescribed her several tests and they will be able to identify the problems after the reports come in.

Dengue symptoms in children are slightly different than in adults. For adults, the initial symptoms are high fever and body aches. However, nausea and coughing are the primary signs for children (newborns to 12-year-olds), said HM Nazmul Ahsan, associate professor of Shaheed Suhrawardy Medical College and Hospital.

"More importantly, it takes around 48 hours for the situation to become critical for adults, while children only have 24 hours, which is why we suggest quick hospitalisation. Children are more prone to developing shock syndrome, which is risky for any dengue patient."

Mother, two sons found dead at home

A woman and her two sons were found dead at their residence in Brahmanbaria's Bancharampur upazila yesterday morning.

Police recovered the bodies around 10:00am from their house in Charchayani village in the upazila's Ayubpur union, Noore Alam, officer-incharge of Bancharampur Model Police Station, told The Daily Star.

The deceased were identified as Jessy Akhter, 35, wife of Shah Alam, an expatriate working in Saudi Arabia, and her sons Mahin, 14, and Mohin, 7, said

The OC said there were injury marks on Jessy and Mahin's heads.

Jessy's seven-month-old daughter, Ojiha, was found alive, he said.

According to police and local sources, they have been living in a building in Charchayani

Jasmine Akhter, a housekeeper who came to work at the house in the morning found the main gate closed and called out to them but got

She collected a key from Jessy's sister-in-law and opened the main gate but found the door to the house locked. She informed the incident to the neighbours and they later informed the police, said the OC.

Law enforcers reached the spot and broke the door of the room and recovered the bodies.

The OC said they are looking into the incident.

Sayema Haque Bidisha, a professor of economics at Dhaka University, said maintaining forex reserves and tackling inflation are essential now.
