

MURDER OF WOMAN, 2 SONS 'Family feud led to the killings' Say police after arresting one in Narsingdi

The murders of an expatriate's wife and their two sons took place in Brahmanbaria following a family feud, said the family and police.

The law enforcers came up with the information after arresting the alleged killer Zahirul Islam, the husband of the woman's niece.

He was held at his in-law's house at Tatapara in Madhabdi, Narsingdi on Tuesday night, said Bancharampur Model Police Station OC Noore Alam. Yesterday, the arrestee gave a confessional statement to a Brahmanbaria court after he was produced before it.

Abul Hossain, father of deceased Jessy Akhter, filed a murder case against unnamed persons.

Her brother Shamim Ahmed said Zahirul is the husband of his niece Anika Akhter. After marriage, Anika frequented Jessy's house following altercations with her husband.

On October 16, Zahirul went to Jessy's house and requested her not to disclose his arrival to his wife and mother-in-law. When Jessy informed the matter to the family members, he had an altercation with her.

At one stage, he hacked Jessy with a sharp weapon. He later killed her two sons -- Mahin, 14, and Mohin, 7 -- as they witnessed the incident.

Abul Hossain said, "Zahirul killed my daughter and grandsons in a planned way." On Tuesday, police recovered the bodies from the house at Charchhayani village in Bancharampur upazila.

KHALEDA CASE Petition hearing adjourned till Nov 1

The High Court yesterday adjourned till November 1 the hearing of a petition filed by BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia challenging the legality of a trial court order that allowed the investigation officer of Niko corruption case to place deposition against her.

The HC bench of Justice Md Nazrul Islam Talukder and Justice Khizir Hayat Lizu passed the adjournment order after concluding the hearing.

Khaleda's lawyer AJ Mohammad Ali said running the proceedings against his client is contradictory to article 27 of the constitution which says: "All citizens are equal before law and are entitled to equal protection of law".

He said two cases were filed in 2007 against Sheikh Hasina and Khaleda Zia over an unsolicited offer from Canadian company Niko. The HC quashed

More patients from outside Dhaka at DMCH

Dengue death toll crosses 1,200-mark

Mohammad Kawsar Hossain, 65, a resident of Jhenaidah, has been undergoing treatment at Dhaka Medical College Hospital since Saturday, after he was admitted with dengue.

Kawsar, who came to Dhaka following a cardiac arrest and was admitted to the National Institute of Cardiovascular Diseases on Thursday, was referred to the DMCH after contracting dengue.

"I will go back to NICVD after recovering from dengue," said Kawsar.

He said there were no dengue patients in Jhenaidah in previous years, but a growing number of people in their area are contracting the mosquito-borne disease this year.

Eighteen-year-old Mohammad Noman, from Daudkandi in Cumilla, was admitted to DMCH yesterday with symptoms of dengue such as vomiting, abdominal pain, and severe headaches.

"Previously my mother and maternal uncle were diagnosed with dengue and received treatment at home," he said. However, they brought Noman to the hospital due to his critical condition, said his uncle Ruhul Amin.

There has been a decrease in dengue cases this month, with the facility

treating half as many patients as the previous month. However, most of the patients are now coming from outside Dhaka, particularly the southern areas of the country, said Safwan Ahmed, a doctor at DMCH.

Meanwhile, the death toll from dengue rose to 1,206 (464 outside Dhaka) this year, with 16 more deaths reported in the last 24 hours till yesterday morning. Of those, 13 were from outside Dhaka.

Besides, 2,495 new patients were hospitalised during the same period.

HM Nazmul Ahsan, associate professor at Shaheed Suhrawardy Medical College Hospital, said better treatment and management facilities are required outside Dhaka, as it takes several hours to reach the capital. It's not possible to get enough fluid supply during that time, causing many patients to collapse even before they are admitted to hospitals.

"Such patients have lower chances of survival as they might suffer a decompensated shock, which reduces their chances of recovery by 50 percent."

Stomach aches, breathing difficulties, weakness, bleeding from gums or nose, and vomiting are the signs for which a patient needs to be hospitalised immediately, he continued. "If a patient is not hospitalised within 24 hours, they may reach the dengue shock syndrome stage."

DEFAMATORY REMARKS Dinajpur mayor jailed for a month

A Dinajpur court sent the municipality mayor to jail for a month, after he surrendered yesterday, for making defamatory remarks about a senior judge of the Supreme Court.

The Chief Judicial Magistrate Court of Zulfikar Ullah passed the order when Syed Jahangir Alam, also assistant organising secretary of Rangpur division of BNP, appeared before it.

Earlier, he also paid Tk 1 lakh as a fine to the court through his lawyers, said ASM Liakat Ali, court inspector in Dinajpur.

On October 12, the SC sentenced the mayor to one month's imprisonment and fined him Tk 1 lakh for the remarks.

On August 18, the Appellate Division issued a contempt of court notice to Jahangir asking him to explain why he should not be punished for the remarks.

Earlier, Jahangir made such comments on a YouTube channel about Justice M Enayetur Rahim over judgement in a case against BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia.

Ex-cop, jail superintendent sued over graft

The Anti-Corruption Commission sued a former police officer and a senior jail superintendent in two districts yesterday, for accumulating wealth beyond their known sources of income.

In Chattogram, ACC filed a case against Md Shah Alam, 59, former DIO at the office of superintendent of police in Chattogram.

According to the case, Shah Alam, in his wealth statements, concealed the information of possessing over Tk 10.74 lakh.

Meanwhile, ACC sued Md Shajahan Ahmed, a former senior jail superintendent in Cumilla; and his wife Khandaker Nurun Nahar Lotus for amassing illegal wealth worth over Tk 2.21 crore.

According to case, the couple has a flat in Malibagh, a house and 10 decimals of land in Tangail, a 3.5 katha plot at Joar Shahara, an SUV, and a huge amount of money in several bank accounts.

The case mentions that the money was earned illegally when Shajahan was posted at Cumilla Central Jail from 1999 to 2022.
