

One killed, 20 hurt in Munshiganj bus accident

A man died after being hit by a bus that lost control and eventually fell into a roadside ditch on the Dhaka-Chattogram highway in Munshiganj's Gazaria upazila yesterday.

Twenty passengers of the Jainpur Paribahan, going to Dhaka from Cumilla, were injured in the accident.

The deceased was identified as Abdur Rob, 65. He died on the spot, said Humayun Kabir, Gazaria highway police in-charge.

The accident occurred around 8:30am when the bus lost control, striking Rob and veering off the road, he said.

Gazaria Upazila Fire Service Station Officer Rifat Mallik said, "Some people were sent to Dhaka in critical condition. The rest are receiving treatment at the Gazaria Health Complex."

establishing an unbiased environment, and ensuring equal opportunities for participation in election campaigns. "The Election Commission should be strengthened for effective and institutionalised control with active involvement of the government, political parties, and relevant organisations in maintaining the proper conduct of elections," he said.

He stressed the importance of refraining

from using religion and sectarianism in election campaigns, and proposed that Border Guard Bangladesh and Rab members patrol sensitive areas from two days ahead and 15 days after the election day.

Awami League had made certain commitments in their election manifesto for the 11th National Parliament election. The parishad had planned a grand rally on November 17 to address the implementation of

those promises. However, the event was postponed, mentioned Dasgupta.

The rally was postponed due to concerns about potential disruptions, such as hartals and blockades announced by various political parties following the election candidacy announcements made two days before the schedule, he added.

Presidents of the organisation Nim Chandra Bhowmik and Nirmal Rozario also spoke at the conference.

at the Shikha Anirban (the Eternal Flame) at Dhaka Cantonment in the morning, paying homage to the martyred armed forces' members who laid down their lives in the Liberation War.

Later, Army Chief General SM Shafiuddin Ahmed, Navy Chief Admiral Mohammad Nazmul Hasan and Air Force Chief Air Chief Marshal Shaikh Abdul Hannan will place wreaths at the Shikha Anirban on behalf of their respective forces.

On the occasion, chiefs of the three services will pay courtesy calls to the president at the Bangabhaban and the prime minister at the Armed Forces Division.

The prime minister will accord a reception to family members of the Bir Shreshthas and selected gallantry award-winning war veterans and their family members at the Army Multipurpose Complex in Dhaka.

The premier will distribute peace award for 2022-23 among five army, three navy and three air force personnel.

Besides, a reception programme will be arranged on behalf of the premier at the Senakunja at the cantonment.

The state-run Bangladesh Television (BTv) will telecast the function live.

Marking the day, the navy chief will accord reception to family members of the

gallantry award winning freedom fighters on the day, while army and air force chiefs are expected to accord reception to gallantry award winning freedom fighters/family members on November 23. Various programmes have also been chalked out at different army garrisons, naval ships, installations and bases of the air force across the country outside Dhaka.
