RESPONSE

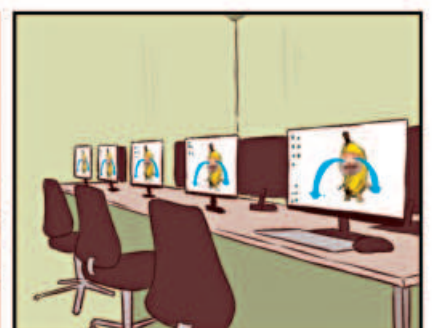
Dear Rishov,
