**First Death Anniversary of Late Mr. Anwarul Amin**



Today is the first death Anniversary of late Mr. Anwarul Amin, who was the Chairman of Impact Foundation Bangladesh, a renowned NGO with international links, dedicated to the prevention and cure of avoidable disabilities in the country. Besides rendering other life-saving activities, it also runs "Jibon Tari", a floating hospital that provides medical services in some of the inaccessible riverine areas of Bangladesh.

Late Mr. Anwarul Amin was a founder-trustee of Impact Foundation Bangladesh and ran the Foundation as Chairman from 2004 till his sad demise in 2022. During this period, Impact Foundation Bangladesh expanded its activities significantly.

Mr. Amin was a very successful innovative banker and a popular social activist. He served in various banks and financial institutions from the early fifties and contributed significantly to the development of the banking sector in newly independent Bangladesh. He established the first Bangladeshi bank (Uttara Bank) in London in March 1972, immediately after the independence of Bangladesh. He was the Head of Operations of BCCI Bank in Bangladesh, China, and Japan from 1980 to 1990. He also served as the President of the China-Bangladesh People's Friendship Association for a long period and contributed to the development of closer relations between the two countries.

late Mr. Amin was born on 26 December 1935 in an illustrious family of Bengal. He left behind his only son Kaiser Tamiz Amin, a renowned financial consultant and only daughter, a well-known journalist, Aasha Mehreen Amin, Joint Editor of The Daily Star, and a host of relatives, friends, and well-wishers to mourn his death. Late Professor Razia Khan Amin, an eminent Author and educationist, was his wife.

He is being keenly remembered with respect and fondness by all who came to know him.
