Potato farmers stare at loss

Recent rains leave newly sown saplings rotting

Potato farmers in Munshiganj district are likely to suffer heavy losses financially as their newly sown potato saplings are rotting due to the recent rains under the influence of Cyclone Michaung.

Saplings were sown across around 16,000 hectares of land so far out of this year's target of 34,346 hectares for potato cultivation in the district. Due to the fields being

submerged under water after rainfall from Wednesday night till Thursday, these potato saplings will all rot over the next couple of days, said farmers in Sirajdikhan, Tongibari, and Sadar upazilas.

Visiting Hoglakandi area of Munshiganj Sadar upazila yesterday, this correspondent saw potato fields were inundated by rain water, while farmers were trying to drain away the water using different

"This year I planted potato



saplings in around 11.5-katha land. All the saplings are submerged in rain water and will rot. I will incur a significant loss," said Samad, a farmer in the area.

"The price of potatoes was high this year. I bought potato seeds at a higher price and cultivated them. Now all those saplings have been damaged by the rain and will not last," said Abdul Selim, another



them.

Contacted, Md Abdul Aziz, deputy director of the Department Agricultural Extension in Munshiganj, said, "We told the farmers to plant the saplings after the cyclone, but many did not listen to our advice. Now we suggest they drain out as much water as possible, this might save some of the saplings from rotting."

"It is not possible to estimate the Several potato farmers echoed extent of damage yet," he added.

467 killed in road accidents in Nov **Says Road Safety Foundation**

At least 467 people were killed and 672 injured in 541 road crashes across the country last month, Road Safety Foundation said yesterday.

Of the deceased, 376 people (80.51 percent) are between 18 and 65 years, the organisation said.

It also said road crashes and deaths have increased last month compared to October this year. At least 421 were killed in 458 road accidents in October, it said.

Meanwhile, 181 people were killed in 207 crashes involving motorcycles in November, which is 38.75 percent of total deaths in last month, it said.

Besides, 106 pedestrians were killed last month, which is 22.69 percent of total deaths in November, it said. Road Safety Foundation compiled the data from media reports.

The traffic on the bridge went back to normal after the buses were recovered.



Around 96.6 percent of Salman F Rahman's annual income of Tk 25.31 crore comes from shares, savings certificates, bank deposits and debentures, according to an affidavit he submitted to the Election Commission.

The vice-chairman of the Beximco Group has assets valued at approximately Tk 312.09 crore, of which over 94 percent are movable bonds, shares of both listed and unlisted companies, and letters of credit.



Of his annual income, Tk 24.45 crore comes from debentures, bank deposits, savings certificates, and shares.

In 2018, Salman reported having an annual income of Tk 9.31 crore. In comparison, his yearly income increased by Tk 16 crore.

She currently holds Tk 46.48 lakh in deposits from banks and financial institutions. Additionally, she possesses savings certificates and fixed deposits amounting to around Tk 21 lakh. None of these financial assets were disclosed

Two more die of dengue

At least two more people died from dengue in the last 24 hours till 8:00am yesterday as the country grappled with a record outbreak of the mosquito-borne disease.

At least 362 dengue patients were hospitalised in that period, according to DGHS.

Dengue has so far claimed at least 1,652 lives this year and nearly 3,16,773 were infected, making this the deadliest year since the first recorded epidemic in 2000.

According to DGHS data, 2,412 dengue patients were undergoing treatment at different hospitals across the country. A total of 3,12,773 patients have so far been released from hospitals.
