Chinese research ship to make resupply call

Says Maldives ministry

The Maldives has granted permission for a controversial Chinese vessel to make a resupply call but it will not undertake any "research", the Indian Ocean archipelago nation's foreign ministry said yesterday.

China's Xiang Yang Hong 3, which has been reportedly turned down port entry by Sri Lanka, is due to call at Male in early February, according to ship monitoring website MarineTraffic.

The vessel will "not be conducting any research while in the Maldivian waters", the foreign ministry said, following media reports from neighbouring India accusing

Beijing of using the ship for "surveillance".

The Maldives said the vessel would stop only for "a port call, for rotation of personnel and replenishment". There was no immediate comment from China.

India is suspicious of China's increasing presence in the Indian Ocean and its influence in Sri Lanka and the Maldives.

India threatens to expel French journalist

A French journalist said yesterday she was facing expulsion from India after two decades for what authorities have termed "malicious and critical" reportage, days before a state visit by President Emmanuel Macron.

Critics say that press freedom in the world's biggest democracy is increasingly under attack, with journalists who touch on sensitive topics often subjected to government rebuke.

The latest is Vanessa Dougnac, a contributor to several French-language publications including the weekly magazine Le Point, who has been based in India for 22 years.

China undergoes rare scrutiny at UN meeting

China underwent scrutiny of its human rights record at a key UN meeting yesterday, with Western countries calling for more protections for Xinjiang Uyghurs and greater freedom in Hong Kong while Beijing said it had made historic progress.

The review at the UN in Geneva is the first since the global body's top rights official released a report in 2022 saying the detention of Uyghurs and other Muslims in China's Xinjiang region may constitute crimes against humanity.

Beijing denies any abuses. China has

China's diplomatic mission did not comment on the reported lobbying. Its delegation in Geneva said yesterday it had made progress since its last UN review in 2018, saying it had lifted nearly 100 million people out of poverty.

Some 163 countries were set to speak at the session and countries had only 45 seconds each to speak.

Many countries lauded China's efforts on human rights, including Ethiopia and Cameroon. Western countries raised concerns including Germany, which cited human rights violations in Xinjiang and Tibet, and Canada which called for China to repeal a controversial Hong Kong national security law. Eric Chan, Hong Kong's chief secretary, praised the law.

France logged record number of asylum requests in 2023

A record number of people sought asylum in France last year, a rise of more than eight percent on the previous year, the county's refugee protection authority said yesterday. The announced increase comes weeks after the government passed a tough new immigration law under pressure from the far right. Around 142,500 people applied in total including 123,400 for the first time -- and around a third of all requests for protection were accepted, the French Office for the Protection of Refugee and Stateless Persons (OFPRA) said in provisional figures. Just 131,000 people had applied in 2022, with a slightly lower proportion of 29 percent receiving a positive response. "This increase is not specific to France, but comes within a European context," OFPRA director Julien Boucher told AFP. "It is much lower than the European average" increase, he added. In Germany, first-time asylum applications rose by more than 50 percent last year to 329,120, official figures showed. In France, the largest number of first-time applicants last year were from Afghanistan for the sixth year in a row, with 17,500 Afghans seeking refuge away from their war-torn country.

CHINA-KYRGYZSTAN 3 dead, dozens hurt as quake hits border

Three people were killed and dozens injured after a 7.0-magnitude earthquake struck along the mountainous China-Kyrgyzstan border yesterday, authorities said. The major quake was registered just after 2:00 am at a depth of 13 kilometres in China's Xinjiang region, about 140 kilometres west of the city of Aksu. Local authorities dispatched a team to the quake's epicentre, Beijing's Xinhua state news agency said, while around 800 people were on standby for any large disaster relief mission. The earthquake caused three deaths, while five other people sustained injuries, CCTV reported yesterday evening.
