

# When the hills cry for help

Politically influential gang continues to raze red hillocks in Tangail

Once what were beautiful hillocks of red earth, are now barren lands.

The Sal and Gajari trees which used to adorn the place, have also disappeared.

The red earth hillocks, locally known as "Tila" or "Chala," that once dotted the Madhupur Garh region from Gazipur to Tangail districts have been gradually destroyed over the years.

In areas like Tarafpur, Asgana, Banshtali, and Latifpur in Tangail's Mirzapur upazila, the hills were leveled and the trees cut down.

Environmentalists blame the greed of unscrupulous people and negligence of the authorities concerned for the razing of hillocks in Mirzapur, Ghatail, Sakhipur and Madhupur upazilas of Tangail.

Some locally influential people with political backing are allegedly involved

in levelling the hillocks to sell the earth to traders. The earth is used in producing bricks at kilns, for road construction, and filling of ponds and low lying areas.

The felled trees are sold for wood.

The status quo is destroying the environmental balance on one hand and increasing

the risk of natural disasters, such as landslides, on the other. Also, heavy trucks used for transporting the earth are damaging the rural roads as well as polluting the environment with dust and smoke, said green activists.

## 3-storey building, 45-bigha land with Tk 2,000 salary!

Postal employee gets nine years in jail

A special court in Rangpur yesterday sentenced a postal department employee to nine years in jail and fined him Tk 28 lakh for illegally amassing movable and immovable property.

The verdict came following a case filed by the Anti-Corruption Commission accusing Md Habibur Rahman, a postal operator for the Gaibandha Postal Department.

The court also ordered the deposit of the fine within 60 official days from the day of judgement, or, in default, he has to stay six more months in jail.

Birkanto Roy, an assistant director of Gaibandha ACC, filed the case on September 30, 2015.

According to the prosecution, Habibur amassed huge property by making false saving documents. Later, an ACC investigation found

that the postal employee, who started his job with a Tk 2,000 monthly salary, owned a three-storey building and 45 bighas of land.

Fixed deposits were also found under his children's names.

Later, the investigation officer filed a charge sheet against him, as the worth of his properties was beyond his income level, said ACC public prosecutor AKM Harun Ur Rashid.

Habibur is facing 10 more cases, he said. Recently, he was also sentenced to nine years in jail by a special court for illegally amassing Tk 56 lakh.

## 'He was not offered teaching contract for vandalism'

Says BRAC University on Asif Mahtab

BRAC University yesterday said the recent act of tearing pages of a textbook published by the government, included in the national curriculum for students enrolled in 7th grade in schools, and asking others to do the same in a public forum, is an act of vandalism, a behaviour not supported by the university.

"The University considers any act of vandalism towards national property as unacceptable behavior and does not tolerate or support such activities," it said in a statement.

"The University, therefore, cannot offer a part-time teaching contract to Mr. Asif Mahtab Utsha for the Spring 2024 semester. However, the University will compensate Mr. Utsha for his time and efforts towards his preparatory work for Spring 2024," it added.

"BRAC University believes, like all great institutions of higher education, its role should be to create space for all views to be discussed and debated constructively, predicated on tolerance and respect. The University believes in the exchange of ideas through dialogue."

"BRAC University respects and fully complies with the country's constitution and laws on all matters. Accordingly, it does not promote homosexuality as has been alleged by some quarters in various social media content. However, the university believes in equal rights and opportunities for every single human being to realize their potential," the statement added.

## Ctg airport health official held with four gold bars

Customs officials yesterday arrested a health officer of Chattogram airport and recovered four gold bars from his possession.

The arrestee, MZA Sharif, works at the Emergency Medical Services Department of the airport, said Assistant Commissioner of Custom House Alif Rahman Nirvul.

To smuggle the gold, the doctor allegedly used the VIP channel pretending to provide emergency medical care to one of the passengers, Md Alauddin, of a flight arriving from the UAE, he said.

Based on a tip-off, customs officials monitored the doctor's moves for the past few days and arrested him yesterday.

"Legal action is being taken against the passenger and the doctor," he said.

Following the incident, Sharif got suspended and the DGHS formed a two-member probe committee to investigate the incident, said officials.
