Dead trees a safety hazard on Satkhira roads

Curled up leafless twigs rattling Parishad, 307 big trees on both with every breeze and decaying tree trunks crowd the roads of

With little or no care, hundreds of dead raintrees, locally known as Shirish, lay abandoned across nine roads in the district.

Planted about three decades ago, their dried-up frail carcasses now pose a serious risk of accident for commuters.

However, there was a time when these trees use to flaunt their Khulna University's forestry and green leaves with the rhythm of winds as locals enjoyed their cool
