

Man hacked to death in Narayanganj

A 28-year-old man was stabbed to death and another injured in the Chashara Balur Math area of Narayanganj on Friday night.

The deceased was identified as Al Amin alias Daniel, 28, of Fatullah, and the injured was Shuvo, 24.

Daniel was involved in an autorickshaw garage business, and Shuvo is a machine operator in a factory, said Taslim Ahmed, inspector (investigation) of Fatullah Model Police Station, reports UNB.

Police and witnesses said some miscreants attacked and stabbed the two and took them away in an autorickshaw. After that, they hacked them again in front of Shuvo's house, in Masdair area.

Locals took the injured to Narayanganj General Hospital, where doctors declared Daniel dead. Shuvo was sent to DMCH.

Relatives claimed that the murder was preplanned and over previous enmity.

"We are looking into the incident, added the inspector.

Once barren, now a farmers' haven

Swampland becomes fertile as salinity reduced following sluice gate closure

Only a year ago, the 7,000 bighas of swampland of Sashikhali beel in Bagerhat's Shatgambuj union used to be barren due to inflow of water with high salinity from Doratana river through a sluice gate.

The area was only used as shrimp enclosures. Now, salinity has reduced significantly after the sluice gate was closed in April last year.

Since then, around 2,500 bighas of swampland have become agriculturally productive, producing 900 tonnes of paddy alongside a good harvest of vegetables and fruits including beans, cucumber, radish, cauliflower, cabbage, gourd, brinjal, and watermelon.

This is also benefiting more than 500 farmers and landowners.

Fish including different carps are also being reared in the water alongside shrimp.

Visiting the area recently, this correspondent saw some farmers planting paddy saplings in the swampland while vegetables were cultivated along the slopes of fish enclosures.

"I have 5.5 bighas of land here. After the salinity reduced, I cultivated 50 maunds of paddy

last season. I am also cultivating some vegetables, watermelon, and rearing fish. I planted paddy saplings on one-bigha land this season," said Bibha Mondal, a farmer from Purba Saira village.

Abdul Hai, a landowner, said, "I own about 100 bighas of land in this beel. But there was no harvest due to salinity. After the inflow of saline water stopped last year, I cultivated Aman paddy and had a bumper yield."

"Of the 2,500 bighas of

swampland that now support agriculture, most of the land is being used for paddy cultivation and fish rearing. At a cost of around Tk 5,000 to Tk 9,000 per bigha of land, a farmer gets yield of around 25-35 maunds of paddy, generating Tk 10,000- Tk 20,000," said farmer Ibrahim Sheikh.

Local UP chairman Sheikh Aktaruzzaman Bachchu said since the area is remote, with no road communication, it is challenging to transport the paddy and vegetables to markets

after harvest. "Also, the area has no electricity connection, so irrigation is difficult in the dry season," he added.

Tanmoy Dutta, upazila agriculture officer, said, "A joint initiative of landowners, farmers and sharecroppers, public representatives, and the Department of Agricultural Extension saw the sluice gate closed in April last year. Since then, around 2,500 bighas of land became cultivable, while the salinity continues to reduce in the rest of the land gradually."

AL leader beaten to death in Kurigram

Two BCL leaders arrested

A local Awami League leader was beaten to death by some youths allegedly led by Sadar upazila Chhatra League general secretary Rezvi Kabir Chowdhury Bindu in Kurigram town on Friday evening over previous enmity.

The deceased is Shariful Islam Sohan, 40, treasurer of the municipal unit AL.

The incident took place around 7:00pm in Khalilganj Bazar area.

Police detained Bindu and Kurigram Polytechnic Institute BCL unit president Jhinuk Mia over the murder, said Al Asad Md Mahfuzul Islam, superintendent of police in Kurigram.

A Kurigram court sent them to jail yesterday.

Sohan's friend Khandkar Redwan Mahmud said while they were going towards the town, some youths riding on bikes led by Bindu attacked them, leaving Sohan seriously injured.

"We took Sohan to a hospital, where doctors declared him dead," he said.

Resident Medical Officer of Kurigram Sadar Hospital Dr Shahinur Islam Sipan said there were injury marks on Sohan's body.

Sohan's wife filed a murder case with the police station against four named and seven unnamed persons.

Sadar Police Station Officer-in-Charge Masudur Rahman said they were trying to arrest the others.

District BCL General Secretary Saddam Hossain said the arrested two were expelled from BCL on Friday night.

Woman killed in Bogura

A woman died yesterday after being hacked allegedly by her husband at Santahar in Bogura's Adamdighi upazila on Friday night.

The deceased is Razia Sultana, 37.

The incident happened at Tea Garden Mahalla over a family dispute, said Bakul Hossain, sub-inspector of Santahar Police Outpost.

They are trying to arrest her husband Badiuzzaman, the SI said.

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is the same for all other workers," said Lipi Begum, a worker of the factory.

Meanwhile, more than a hundred workers of Rupashi Group of Industries Ltd demonstrated over similar reasons in front of Narayanganj Press Club in the morning. They said owner of the factory in Fatullah's Kutubpur area closed it in November last year without paying their salaries for three months.

"At least 700 workers of the factory have not been paid their salaries for three months," said Kabir Hossain Raju, president of district committee of the United Federation of Garments Workers.

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of the mega projects: traffic jams reduced on some main roads, yet it is acute on alleys and lanes, highlighting the need for a comprehensive plan to alleviate congestion."

He said the implementation of Strategic Transport Plan for Dhaka (STP 2005/25) is yet in the primary phase. Dhaka is the slowest city in the world despite the mega projects, he added.

In the keynote paper, he suggested to extend the elevated expressway to Kutubkhali area from Farmgate. Additionally, he stressed the importance of enhancing public transport and implementing a

disciplined traffic system alongside mega projects.

He recommended incorporating the low and middle income people's necessity in taking all plans related to the traffic system.

Kazi Md Shifun Newaz, assistant professor at the Accident Research Institute (ARI) of Buet, said, "To maximise the benefits of the metro rail, certain actions need to be taken such as reducing private car usage in the city, improving the public transport system, and relocating rickshaws away from main roads."

"The traffic system ought to be developed in cooperation with buses and trains, with a crucial focus

on overcoming obstacles on footpaths," he added.

LGRD Minister Md Tazul Islam said the growth of per capita income among the populace has increased traffic jams in the cities.

"There is no possibility to reduce the traffic jam overnight. We are working phase by phase. You [people] should recognise the progress and propose realistic recommendations," he added.

He suggested implementing a policy where families are restricted to owning only one car.
