VANISHING VOICES

Only 4 people speak 'Kui' in Bangladesh

A language is quietly but surely becoming extinct in some villages at the tea estates of Moulvibazar, Habiganj, and Sylhet, along the Bangladesh-India border.

There resides the Kandha community. Their mother tongue "Kui", also known as Kandh, Khond, Khondo, and Kuinga, is on the verge of extinction.

Kui is a south-central Dravidian language. Scripted in Odia, the language is predominantly spoken in Odisha, and parts of the neighbouring Jharkhand in

But in Bangladesh, the language whispers its last stories on the lips of just four elderly individuals of the community. Others, mostly speak Jangli a combination of Bangla and Odia

Besides, there are no written scripts in Kui, meaning the language may die with the remaining four people who can speak

The Kandha people arrived in these lands during the British era as tea garden workers. They settled, built lives, and their voices intertwined with the local Bangla and Odia, giving birth to the unique "Jangli" language. This became

A 2016 survey identified 539 Kandha households in 30 tea estates across Sylhet

Kandha, a 65-year-old Shyamoli resident of Kalighat Tea Garden in Sreemangal, is one of the last four speakers of Kui. "I speak in this language only when I

Summer Institute of Linguistics, an international organisation working with indigenous languages, recently conducted a survey on the Kandha community and Kui as a part of their study on 20 endangered languages in the world.

According to SIL, 76 percent of Kandha community members in Moulvibazar mentioned Odia as their mother tongue with 11 percent saying it to be Kui. However, only 42 percent use Odia while less than one percent use Kui to communicate.

> An accepted approach for assessing the status of languages around the world is the "Fishman Criteria", or Graded Intergenerational Disruption Scale. scale has eight levels, with the language considered endangered if it goes above level four. Kui's current status

is specified above level six, said Cornelius Tudu, country director of SIL International Bangladesh.

Porimol Baraik, a researcher, said, "According to Article 30 of the International Convention on the Rights of the Child, of which Bangladesh is a signatory, individuals should not be deprived of the right to use language with other members of their community."

Bangladesh's International Mother Language Institute Act-2010 also stresses on preservation of languages and introduction of written forms of all the languages of the indigenous groups, he

'COST ESTIMATE LEAKED' Ruet scraps Tk 5.20cr e-tender

Rajshahi University of Engineering and Technology scrapped an e-tender of Tk 5.20 crore for renovation projects yesterday over allegations of leaking confidential official cost estimates to at least five bidders.

The decision was taken following recommendations of a probe committee after it detected a "possible leak", said Md Shahadot Hossain, chief engineer of Ruet.

"We will be re-issuing the tender soon," he said. A three-member estimate committee consisting of Prof Md Jahangir Alam, RUET vice chancellor, Dr Mhia Md Zaglul Shahadat, director of planning and development, and Md Shahadot Hossain, chief engineer, are responsible for keeping the cost estimates confidential till the date of opening tender, said two senior officials of Ruet.

The leak compromises fairness of a bidding process by helping certain bidders to win the works, they said, asking not to be named.

The compromise occurs as the open tendering method (OTM) follows a procedure to reject tender quotes offering more than ten percent above or below the official cost estimates, they said.

Meanwhile, Ruet on January 28 invited tenders in eight different groups for maintenance and renovation works of eight buildings.

Some 15 to 17 construction bidders submitted tenders for each group and the tenders were opened on February 13.

Five of the eight bidders, who won the works by offering lowest evaluated prices, happened to have offered prices just below ten percent of estimated costs as contradictory to the OTM rule.

When the matter drew criticism, the authority formed a three-member committee on February

The committee headed by Prof Md Kamruzzaman of Civil Engineering department submitted its report on February 19 finding "scope of suspicion" and suggesting re-issuing the tender, Ruet officials said.

"The leak is impossible as it involves responsible officials. Still, we're re-issuing the tender for fairness," said Dr Mhia Md Zaglul Shahadat, director of Ruet's planning & development.

At least 10 people were injured in an infighting between two factions of the Awami League in Munshiganj vesterday.

Witnesses said incident took place in Bakultala area in Sadar upazila around noon.

Police said there has been a dispute between Adhara union Awami League general secretary Suruj Mia and ward-2 AL president Ali Hossain Sarkar over establishing supremacy in the area.

Yesterday, the followers of Suruj Mia opened fire on Ali Hossain's people near Bakultala High School, injuring three people -- Shakeel, 22, Jewel, 25, and The injured were taken to Munshiganj General

59 proxy Dakhil examinees held in Naogaon


