'I jumped off the roof to survive'

"Where's the emergency exit? where's the emergency exit?" people were shouting all around.

But to their horror, they found there wasn't any functional emergency exit through which they can save their life from the inferno that took place on Thursday.

Md Iqbal, a waiter at Mejbani Khana of the building, was recounting how a routine day at work turned into a nightmare.

Survivors yesterday alleged that there was no emergency exit in the seven-storey commercial building on Bailey Road that caught fire on

Taking treatment in hospitals, they yesterday described how people

resorted to extreme measures to save their lives amid the tragedy. Lying on a bed in Dhaka Medical College Hospital's Ward 102, Iqbal described his ordeal to The Daily Star.

"I was working as usual, like other days. Suddenly, I saw smoke all around. It was difficult to even breathe," he said.

'There were many people running towards the rooftop to save their lives, and I did the same. It was quite a struggle, but I somehow made it to the rooftop, from where the firefighters eventually rescued me," he

Iqbal, who considers himself fortunate to be alive, said there was no way to escape the inferno as there were no emergency exits in the building. "Since the fire originated from the ground floor, there was no option


of escaping [the building] using the stairs," he added. Mujahidul Islam Jubayer, who works as a chef at Khana's, which is

located on the second floor of the building, echoed the same. "While I was cooking, our manager alerted us about a fire downstairs

and instructed us to evacuate to the roof. On the rooftop, we saw many people jumping off to escape the flames and smoke. I followed suit, and after that, I have no idea what happened to me."

He is now undergoing treatment at the DMCH.

At least 46 people died and 12 were injured in the fire.

he recounted the fire incident and how he and his family survived with becoming the help of the brave fire fighters.

He said he and his two daughters, Waziha Zaman Majumder, 12 and Wazah Zaman Majumder, 7, along with his wife advocate Mahrufa Gulshan Ara, went to the restaurant to spend some quality family time together.

"It was a sudden decision to go to the restaurant, as it was just two buildings away from our home," he said.

after they Soon placed their orders at the restaurant, Kamruzzaman smelled something burning saw smoke rising from the lower floors.

"Due to my research and work on disaster management, I could sense the danger," he said. "Looking out the window, I saw people gathering and shouting, pointing towards a building across the street. Smoke was also rising beside the restaurant window."

"I didn't waste any time and decided to leave the restaurant premises as soon as possible, and planned to go upstairs," he continued.

"There were about 10-12 people in the restaurant at the time. I instructed them to leave immediately as Nazmul Hasan, at DMCH trapped inside. He has been well," he said.

There was no safety gear in the restaurant, he recalled. As they moved out of the restaurant to the lobby, a space that can barely fit 12-15 people, they found smoke coming heavily from downstairs.

"Dozens of people were trying to go upstairs. Meanwhile, some people were attempting to go downstairs too," herecalled, adding, "Soon they realised going down wouldn't be possible through the thick, Kamruzzaman.

professor. "However, the roof provided some fresh air but did not guarantee our safety. As time passed, the smoke and heat from the fire intensified, relentlessly rising towards the rooftop, and, shortly afterwards, and fear gripped the approximately 40 people, mostly women, who had taken shelter there," he said.

As smoke began to engulf the roof, people tried to save themselves by covering their faces with wet clothes. Many sat down in prayer on the roof, desperately praying for survival, he recalled.

"Just as hope dwindled, we heard the news of the fire service's arrival. However, we couldn't see the crane due to a rooftop restaurant blocking the view," Kamruzzaman continued.

"Then, after some time, we saw a firefighter climb up to the roof. Finally, around midnight, we spotted the crane," he

He said the fire fighters, over the next two hours, gradually lifted and evacuated people in groups children and women first, and then others.
