

Five jailed for vandalising idols

A Chattogram court has sentenced five men to two years imprisonment each for vandalising idols that were being built for Durga Puja in Raozan, Chattogram in 2008.

Judge Rabiul Awal of Chattogram District and Judge Court-1 delivered the judgement on Tuesday.

The information came to light after the case document was released yesterday.

The convicts are Nurul Amin, Bedar Meah, Kamal Uddin, Nezam Uddin and Jamal Uddin.

The court had acquitted two other accused as the charges brought against them could not be proved, he added.

Earlier, all seven accused were acquitted of the vandalism charges in 2019.

But the five among the seven were found guilty in the retrial, said Hari Ranjan Nath, additional public prosecutor.

According to the case, the convicts vandalised the idols at a mandop in September, 2008.

Amlendu Banik, an adviser of the Durga Puja Festival Committee, filed a case with Raozan Police Station, accusing the seven people.

New election, same old promises

Mymensingh city mayor announces manifesto ahead of polls

Incumbent mayor of Mymensingh City Corporation, Ekramul Haque Titu, has pledged to address civic problems on priority basis if he is re-elected for a second term.

Titu said this while announcing his 23-point election manifesto at a press conference yesterday noon at Mymensingh Press Club auditorium.

However, voters and civil society members said many of these pledges made by the candidate in the previous election were not fulfilled after he assumed the role of mayor.

The Mymensingh city Corporation election is slated for March 9.

After declaration as a city corporation in 2018, the maiden MCC polls held in 2019 saw Titu

elected unopposed as mayor.

This time, a total of 149 candidates are vying for 33 general posts of ward commissioner while 69 are contesting for reserved seats for women. The voting will be held using electronic voting machines (EVMs). Mymensingh city has a total 3,36,490 eligible voters, said election officials.

In his manifesto, Titu stressed on steps to overcome the menacing traffic congestion in the city, including taking experts' opinions, constructing overpasses and

Body recovered

Police yesterday recovered the body of an unidentified youth from a rubber plantation in Tangail's Madhupur upazila.

The body, bearing burns on the face and numerous other places, was found by locals in the rubber plantation in Pargachha area of the upazila around noon, police said.

On information, police went to the spot and recovered the body, said Mollah Azizur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Madhupur Police Station.

The body was later sent to Tangail General Hospital morgue for autopsy and police are looking for the identity of the deceased, aged approximately 24 years. The exact cause of death will be found after we get the post-mortem report, he added.

to decline. Banks are suffering from a liquidity crisis. Many banks are going bankrupt."


She also said that to reduce the price of goods, it is not enough to take action against the syndicate.

"The dollar crisis must be resolved. If there is no dollar, goods cannot be imported. And, if there is no supply of goods in the market, unscrupulous traders will raise prices

by creating an artificial crisis."

She said strict measures should be taken against corruption to ensure good governance. Even if allegations of corruption are raised against influential persons, actions should be taken against them as per law. The rule of law must be ensured.

It should also be ensured that everyone gets a fair trial, she added.
