The home ministry on June 20, 2013, handed the case to Rab upon a High Court order following an appeal by Rabbi.

Currently, there are 108 factories, land grabbers and encroachers, then 43 shipyards, 23 small factories, 22 industrial establishments, 19 warehouses and 17 brick kilns on the
