

Convocation of DIU held

Daffodil International University (DIU) held its 11th convocation yesterday at Shawdhinata Sommelen Kendro of the university at Daffodil Smart City, Birulia Savar, Dhaka, said a press release.

Education Minister Mohibul Hassan Chowdhury presided over the convocation ceremony and conferred the degrees.

Prof Franco Gandolfi, Professor of Leadership, Georgetown University, USA attended as the convocation speaker.

Dr Md Sabur Khan, chairman, Board of Trustees; Prof M Lutfar Rahman, vice chancellor of the university; and Dr Dipu Moni, a lawmaker, spoke on the occasion. A total of 6,284 students has been conferred upon graduation and post-graduation degrees. Among them, 12 were awarded "Gold Medal" in different categories of Chancellor's, Chairman's BoT and Vice Chancellor's Award, based on their outstanding results.

Oil smuggling from mother vessels goes on unabated

Some businessmen and shipbreaking yard owners have long been involved in smuggling fuel from mother vessels at Chattogram Port, due to poor monitoring by the authorities concerned.

Many crew members on mother vessels, responsible for transporting thousands of tonnes of oil from foreign locations, are directly involved in organised crime, said police.

During this process, personnel who're on board anchored mother vessels send signals to the boats of the illicit traffickers, who then approach them in lighter vessels.

Once they reach the outer anchorage in the deep sea, they get their plastic drums filled with fuel oil -- including petrol, octane, diesel, and furnace oil -- transact

in cash, and return through the river Karnaphuli.

Unrefined edible oil is also looted in the illegal operation.

During the whole covert mission, they evade the law enforcement agencies. After

collection, they sell the oil in various local markets, causing a huge revenue loss to the state.

Locals and police said Karnaphuli, Patenga, EPZ, and Khatunganj areas have become dens of smuggled oil.

According to the sources at River Police, Coast Guard (East Zone), and Bangladesh Petroleum Corporation (BPC), the oil traffickers have organised themselves into syndicates and have long been active in such smuggling.

BPC, which is entrusted with importing, distributing, and marketing oil and petroleum products, expressed frustration over the failure to prevent such illicit transport.

To eliminate this, around three years ago, BPC recommended that Chattogram District Administration initiate mobile court drives. But the matter has gotten stuck in the official process.

BPC officials said they sent a letter to the district administration on January 11, 2021. But steps are yet to be taken.

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Trucker shot in Dhaka

A truck driver was shot in Dhaka's Sabujbagh area yesterday.

Md Alam, 48, was admitted to DMCH with a bullet wound in the right leg.

Truck owner Golam Faruk said 7-8 men intercepted their vehicles by throwing stones at it, chased Alam down and started beating him. At one stage they shot him, he added. However, he said he couldn't identify the attackers and don't know the reason behind the attack. Inspector Bachchu Mia, in-charge of DMCH Police Outpost, said Alam was out of danger.

2011 VIOLENCE CASE  
BNP leader Hafiz granted bail

A Dhaka court yesterday granted bail to BNP Vice-Chairman Maj (retd) Hafiz Uddin Ahmed in a 2011 political violence case, in which he was convicted in December last year.

Judge Mohammed Ash-Shams Joglul Hossain of Dhaka's Metropolitan Sessions Judge's Court passed the order after the defence filed a bail petition with the court, state lawyer Tapash Kumar Pal told The Daily Star.

On March 5, another Dhaka court sent Hafiz to jail after rejecting his bail petition in the same case. He surrendered before the court in the case that day.

On December 28 last year, Hafiz, BNP Vice-Chairman Air Vice Marshal (retd) Altaf Hossain Chowdhury, and six others were jailed for different terms in the case filed with Gulshan Police Station.

Altaf, Hafiz, and Major (retd) Md Hanif were sentenced to 21 months imprisonment, while five others were jailed for 42 months for illegally gathering and torching vehicles.

SCBA POLLS VIOLENCE  
Kazal sent on a four day remand

A Dhaka court yesterday placed pro-BNP lawyer Ruhul Quddus Kazal on a four-day police remand in connection with a case filed over Friday's violence centring the Supreme Court Bar Association election.

He was the secretary candidate of the pro-BNP platform in the polls.

Dhaka Metropolitan Magistrate Mohammad Nurul Huda Chowdhury passed the order after investigation officer Abul Kalam Azad, inspector of the Detective Branch (DB), produced him before the court with a seven day remand prayer, said a court police. Kazal was arrested on Saturday near his Purana Paltan chamber.

On Friday, assistant attorney general Saifur Rahman Siddique Saif, who was assaulted centring the polls violence, filed the case with Shahbagh Police Station naming independent candidate Nahid Sultana Juthi, Kazal and 18 others.

On Saturday, another Dhaka court placed five lawyers -- Kazi Bashir Ahmed, Osman Chowdhury, Tushar, Tariqul and Sumon -- on a three day remand after they were produced before it with a five day remand prayer.

The vote counting in the two-day SCBA election was halted on Friday following an altercation due to alleged interference from a group of outsiders on behalf of a candidate. They attacked some lawyers who were present at the polling centre. A lawyer suffered injuries and other lawyers, including candidates and members of the election subcommittee, left the SCBA premises amid a tense situation.

Mason stabbed to death 'by co-worker'

A man was stabbed to death allegedly by his co-worker in Dhaka's Shah Ali area yesterday morning. The deceased was identified as Al Amin alias Ruhul Amin, 30, a mason.

The incident took place near Mukto Bangla market around 8:00am. With critical injuries, Al Amin was rushed to Dhaka Medical College Hospital where doctors declared him dead around 10:30am, said the victim's father Abul Hossain.

Inspector Bachchu Mia, in charge of DMCH police outpost, said there were stab wounds on Al Amin's body, and that one person was detained for questioning. The victim's father said, "Al Amin left home for work early in the morning and later we came to know that his co-worker stabbed him."

Ridoy Mia, a co-worker who took him to DMCH, said they had been waiting near the market for work since morning. "I left him there to bring a spade. Minutes later, I returned and saw him in pool of blood," he said.

Mizanur Rahman, a sub-inspector of Shah Ali Police Station, said relatives of the deceased and people present during the incident said Al Amin was stabbed to death by his colleague. "We are investigating the incident to know what happened," he said.

Three siblings jailed for extortion

A Dhaka court yesterday sentenced three siblings to seven years' imprisonment in an extortion case.

Judge Mohammad Nazrul Islam of the Special Judge's Court-10 of Dhaka delivered the verdict, said state lawyer Azad Rahman.

The convicts are Najrul Islam, Mohammad Siraj, and Mohammad Taju.

During the verdict's delivery, only Siraj was present in the courtroom. The court also issued conviction warrants against Najrul and Taju, who are absconding.

During the trial, 14 prosecution witnesses testified before the court.

According to the case documents, on May 14, 2013, Najrul and his two brothers demanded Tk 5,000 from Enayet Hossain, a steel trader in Begumganj area of Old Dhaka's Gendaria, threatening to kill him with a knife.
