Parliaments in Canada on March 15, effective from May 6.

Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau welcomed the appointment which has been made in consultation with the Senate.

Shaila, raised in Ottawa, holds a Bachelor's in English and Political Science from Carleton University. With over 15 years of Senate experience, she had various leadership roles in the Red Chamber, ranging from Principal Clerk, Deputy Principal Clerk, and Procedural Clerk of the Senate Committees Directorate.

Granddaughter of Poet Jasimuddin, Shaila's recent role was Clerk Assistant of Senate Committees.

Shaila will manage day-to-day operations of the legislative process, advise the Speaker, oversee the swearing-in of new senators and ensure stewardship of legal archives in her new role.

Shaila began her journey at the Senate Committees Directorate in 2007 as a Procedural Clerk.

of 29 essential commodities.

"The Department of Agriculture Marketing has its committees at the district, upazila, and central level. Our responsibility will be to monitor the prices of products from producer level to wholesale and then to retail level," he said.

Now the DAM, Directorate of Consumer Rights Protection Affairs, UNOs, and DCs will all coordinate together to bring down prices of daily necessities. Hopefully, the price will come down to a logical level, he pointed out.

Amid soaring prices of commodities, the government has fixed prices of 29 essential products, including onion, broiler chicken, mutton, beef, and eggplant, at retail, wholesale, producer and production levels.

In a circular issued on Fridav (15 March), the Department of Agricultural Marketing requested the authorities concerned to sell the



Watermelon price beyond consumers' reach

Despite a good supply of watermelons in Patuakhali markets, consumers are not able to buy the seasonal fruit due to high price. It is one of the most sought after fruits during Ramadan.

This year, watermelon has been cultivated on 22,398 hectares of land in Galachipa, Rangabali, Baufal, Kalapara, Dasmina, Dumki and Mirzapur upazilas of Patuakhali, said Nazrul Islam, deputy director of the Department of Agricultural Extension in the district.

Visiting different markets in Patuakhali district, including New Market and Hetalia Bandhghat Bazar, this correspondent saw retailers selling the fruit at Tk 60-90 per kilogramme, after buying it from wholesalers at an average of Tk 350 per piece.

The small sized watermelons weigh around 4-5 kg, medium sized ones weigh 7-8 kg and large watermelons weigh 9 kg or more.

"If we don't sell watermelons at per kg rate, we incur losses. If a watermelon costs Tk 150-200 for small size, Tk 250-300 for medium size and Tk 400 or more for large ones, buyers don't buy it. But if it can be sold at per kg rate, many buyers show interest," said Bashir Gazi, a retailer at Hetalia Bandhghat Bazar.

Retailer Hossain Anwar said, "Watermelons have just hit the market 250 watermelons from my 3 bighas of land

are also charging high prices so we are compelled to sell it at a higher price."

Abdus Salam, a resident of Moukaran village said,"Watermelon is a refreshing fruit so it has good demand during Ramadan. But the price is out of my reach." Other customers echoed him.

Meanwhile, watermelon farmers are largely deprived by wholesalers due to unfair pricing.

Growers said the wholesalers are buying their produce at only Tk 30-35 apiece, while those are later sold to retailers at Tk 250-400 apiece.

Patuakhali deputy commissioner Noor Qutubul Alam during a meeting at the DC's Office recently discussed the efforts to keep market prices stable during Ramadan, where the high price of watermelon was discussed.

At the meeting, DC Noor Alam instructed all concerned to take steps to ensure that watermelons are sold per piece instead of per kg rate in the retail market.

added. He said he joined as professor in February 2022 and was suspended in May 2023, meaning he still had time to meet the requirements.

"I also failed to enroll in a university for PhD programme in fall semester last year due to the suspension order," he added. Teachers said authorities filed a general diary with the local police station, alleging Mehedi and unknown others were involved in the poster publication and distribution process.

The police later sought a Patuakhali court order to investigate the matter, but the court on June 18 last year rejected the request saying "allegations made in the GD were not found to be true primarily".

"I came to know about the hijacked ship from international media. It is unfortunate and worrisome," he said.

The media should also be careful of what they publish, he added

He called upon the ship's crew and their family members to have patience. Based on his past experience, he said the pirates often Somali behave rudely with the hostages and force them to send messages to family members back home to compel the ship's authority to pay the ransom promptly.

"It is wise for the ship's crew to behave well with the pirates in the present runs out, that may bring circumstances to avoid any untoward incident," he said. crew. So, it is necessary Somali pirates to exercise caution to this hijack ships for ransom end," the captain added.

"There is no certainty as to how long the crew will have to remain hostages. So, it is necessary to use the ship's stored food, water, and fuel responsibly during this time. The crew would have to do rationing to last longer with the food and

water," Farid continued. "Sometimes, the pirates may bring in food from the mainland after anchoring the ship, but restocking fresh water for consumption is difficult once the ship's stock becomes exhausted,' he said.

Abul Mansur Ahmad was known for his strong stand in favour of regional autonomy of East Pakistan. He also made remarkable contributions to industrialisation of the long neglected East Pakistan. He always propagated secularism in a manner unparalleled in the forties, fifties and sixties.

Ahmad's publications include great satires like "Aina", "Asmani Purdah", "Gulliverer Safar Nama" and "Food Conference". He also penned insightful works on social and political history of Bengal such as "Bangladesher Culture". He has two autobiographical writings -- "Atma Katha" and "Amar Dekha Rajnitir Panchash Bachar".

Abul Mansur Ahmad was born in 1898 in Dhanikhola village of Trishal, Mymensingh. Bangla Academy has published Ahmad's writings which are available in four volumes now.
