A hidden gem of Tangail

When it comes to sweets, Tangail is mostly known for the famous Porabari Chamcham.

However, the Chamcham isn't the only good thing in Tangail in terms of sweet delicacies, as there are many hidden gems in the district that a person with a sweet tooth would love to know about.

One such hidden gem of the district is the traditional "Sandesh of Jamurki," which has a wonderful taste and mindblowing aroma. Anyone who eats it once will desire to have it over and over again.

The popularity of this sandesh can be attributed to the use of milk and other pure ingredients to ensure high-quality standards for consumers.

Around 80 kilometres from

sits Kalidas Mistanna Bhandar, right next to the Dhaka-Tangail highway.

During the British period, Jamurki and its surrounding areas were inhabited by Zamindars. One Madan Mohan Saha from the village would make sweets and sell them to the Zamindars.

After his death, his son Kalidas Saha took over the family business. Later, he started producing and selling two kinds of sandesh made with milk, sugar, and molasses (pataligur). With the passage of time, the reputation of his sandesh spread throughout the district.

During a recent visit to Kalidas Mistanna Bhandar, this correspondent saw the owner sitting in the shop and selling sweets along with a few employees. Behind the shop is the factory where the sweets are produced. Around 8-10 employees were busy making sweets in the factory.

Most of the customers visit the shop for its famous sandesh.

Only a few days ago, each kg of sandesh was sold for Tk 700. However, it is now being sold for Tk 800 per kg, he said.

Samar Saha claimed that rising prices of commodities, including milk, have resulted in an increase in the price of their sandesh.

"We use pure milk and highquality molasses from Rajshahi. Therefore, if we don't increase the price, the quality will fall," he said.

Samar also shared that there is no other branch of Kalidas Mistanna Bhandar anywhere else. Since the GI tag for Tangail's

famous Cahmcham has already received recognition, initiatives are already underway to claim the GI tag for Jamurki's sandesh. Tangail Deputy Commissioner

Malaysian authorities to improve the situation for Bangladeshi workers and ensure their labour rights are protected.

BCSM expressed concern about the situation of Bangladeshi workers who migrated to Malaysia for employment in 2022. The group claims that "extra migration costs" widespread joblessness have intensified the problems faced by these workers.

Citing government data, BCSM said over 4,00,000 Bangladeshi workers have migrated to Malaysia since 2022 through a "syndicate system" operated recruiting agencies.

Media reports, according to BCSM, suggest that between 1,00,000 and Bangladeshi 2,00,000 workers are currently facing difficulties, including joblessness, in Malaysia.

The statement concluded by urging the Bangladesh High Commission in Kuala Lumpur to be more vigilant in verifying and approving demand letters from Malaysian companies.

distinct facial features such as slanted eyes, a flat nose, and a small chin.

According to the Population and Housing Census 2022, out of a total of 23,61,604 persons with disabilities, 1.08 percent or 25,505 are diagnosed with Down syndrome. However, there are no statistics on the number of children with this condition.

Parents of children with Down syndrome all have different struggles.

"When the doctor informed us about the condition of our son Ramim*, his father struggled to accept the reality," said Ruksana Amin*.

"And one day, he left us. From then on, I raised Ramim alone, despite all the odds," she said.

"Over time, as Ramim excelled in his academic and personal life, his father realised his mistake," Ruksana added.

Raisul Alam*, a factory worker in Mohammadpur, is extremely worried about how to raise his daughter, Fatima*.

"It is hard for me to take care of her with my salary. She always stays at home because it's unsafe outside. Out of fear, we did not admit her to school either," he said.

"What worries me most is who will marry her? Will she find someone who loves her as much as we do?" Alam added.
