Book on Nordic influence in S Asia launched

A book titled "A New Testament" by Prof Tone Bleie was unveiled yesterday at the Residence of the Norwegian Ambassador to Bangladesh, Espen Rikter-Svendsen.

The book by Prof Tone Bleie explores Scandinavian missionary endeavours in Eastern British India and their impact on indigenous communities

Bleie's examines the intertwined histories of Scandinavian settlers and Santal, Boro, and Bengali groups. It sheds light on missionary activities during the Santal rebellion and their role in societal transformation.

According Ambassador Rikter-Svendsen, the book reveals a lesser-known aspect of Nordic history in South emphasised He significance understanding the region's

socio-economic dynamics. The discussion included insights from Prof Mesbah Kamal, Shamsul Huda, and Prof Anwarul Karim, highlighting the book's multifaceted exploration.

'Spare us the shame of rundown buses' Quader urges transport leaders

Road Transport and Bridges Obaidul Quader Minister yesterday urged transport leaders to save him and the country from embarrassment by fixing rundown buses.

"I want a solution from the [transport] leaders. Things cannot go on like this," Quader said at a preparatory

meeting at BRTA headquarters ahead of Eid-ul-Fitr. Shajahan Khan, president of Bangladesh Road Transport Workers Federation and presidium member of Awami League, alongside Mashiur Rahman Ranga, president of Bangladesh Road Transport Owners Association, were present at the meeting.

He said journalists questioned him about the rundown buses when he went to inaugurate a ramp of Dhaka Elevated Expressway on Wednesday. They even questioned him why he could not bring changes even after leading the ministry for 12 years.

JAILING JOURNO UNO summoned

The Information Commission has summoned Nokla Upazila Nirbahi Officer Sadia Ummul Banin in Sherpur to explain her alleged non-cooperation with a local journalist who sought information from her office under the Right to Information Act.

The UNO will have to appear before the commission on April 2, information ministry sources said.

The order came following an inquiry by Shahidul Alom Jhinuk, a member of the commission and a former district judge.

Shafiuzzaman Rana, 45, Nokla correspondent for Bangla daily Desh Rupantor, was jailed for six months by a mobile court, led by Shihabul Arif, assistant commissioner (land), for "misconduct" while seeking information at the UNO office on March 5.

He was, however, released from jail eight days later, after the incident sparked outrage among various journalist organisations. "We have no jurisdiction over the mobile court process. So, we summoned the UNO, not the AC (land) as he is not part of this process," said an official of the Information Commission Secretariat.

Canada wants to sell more Dash-8 aircraft to Biman

Canada has expressed interest in selling more Dash-8 aircraft to Biman Bangladesh Airlines.


Canadian Ambassador Bangladesh Lilly Nicholls expressed the interest while meeting Civil Aviation and Tourism Minister Muhammad Faruk Khan at the latter's Secretariat office yesterday.

"Canada is also interested in doing engine repairs, overhauling and maintenance of various aircraft engines through Canadian Commercial Corporation on a G2G basis," said the ambassador.

Bangladesh has procured three new Dash-8 aircraft from De Havilland Canada in the recent years. Fifteen new aircraft have already been added to Biman's fleet and expansion and new regional and international routes are in works, said the minister. "Following a formal

offer from Canada, a decision, considering the needs of the aircrafts, will be taken. Their proposal for overhauling will be negotiated between the relevant authorities," he added.
