found dead; and ten died by suicide; among other outcomes.

The ones entrusted with delivering justice for the vulnerable are turning into the oppressors, the press release said quoting the speakers.

The investigation into the death of 15-year-old house-help Preeti Urang, who fell from the ninth-floor flat of The Daily Star's Executive Editor Syed Ashfaul Haque, is yet to be completed, the press release added. Furthermore, seven-year-old Ferdousi, who was injured after falling from the same flat seven months ago, is also awaiting justice, the speakers added.

As per the National Child Labour Survey, there are 1.25 lakh domestic child workers in the country, with 80 percent of them being girls. Speakers said that while the Domestic Workers Protection and Welfare Policy was formulated as an initial measure to safeguard house helps, its implementation is still pending.

Executive Director of Amrai Pari Jote Jinat Ara Haque, Chief Executive of MSF Md Saidur Rahman, DWRN's Md Abul Hossain, Md Barkat Ali of BLAST, Nasrin Ahmed of Manusher Jonno Foundation, spoke among others at the event.

Mohammad Rassel Sheikh, superintendent of police in Kishoreganj, who was present at the scene, said operation will continue until the missing persons are rescued.

He also said, "The bulk carrier could not be seized yet. With the help of the river police, efforts are

ongoing to identify it. A person has been detained and was being interrogated in this regard, he added.

At least 21 people were in the trawler when the bulk carrier coming from the opposite direction collided against the trawler on Friday, leading to its capsizing.

of Swachip-BSMU unit. "But, in this case, the VC is working to appoint more than 100 doctors, employees and about 30 officers at the last moment," he alleged.

"In the last three years, the VC has appointed many employees through huge financial transactions, which has been reported by the media. We demand a judicial inquiry into it."

Contacted, Prof Sharfuddin said, "I heard they assaulted some people. I will talk to law enforcers in this regard."

About allegations, he said, "The appointments have already been decided and the syndicate meetings scheduled have also been held. Those who are opposing now didn't come to me earlier."

"Every appointment was done transparently." Meanwhile, the BSMU authorities have banned all kinds of gatherings on the campus until further order, said a notice signed by its Proctor Prof Habibur Rahman. The notice, however, did not mention the reason behind the ban.

against collaborators, and memorials of national heroes like Bangabandhu and martyred intellectuals.

Lincoln himself collected this evidence of war over the years. "What I've done is simply collecting stories. If these stories reveal a freedom fighter, then the credit belongs to them. But if it exposes a Razakar, remember, they weren't outsiders, but our own people. Facing this truth is crucial," said Lincoln.

Lincoln, assisted by his wife Prof Nazmun Nahar, started the museum in 2012.

"We started displaying our collected evidence of the war in the living room; then those gradually spilled to the balcony. When the balcony could no longer hold, even our bedrooms were not spared. During the day, visitors explore our house. At night, it becomes our family space again," Lincoln said.

The Ministry of

Liberation War Affairs is constructing a multi-storied building beside Lincoln's residence. Once completed, the museum will be shifted there.

"I felt that the memory of the Liberation War was fading among several generations during the two-decade-long rule by anti-liberation forces since the assassination of Bangabandhu. I decided to do something to preserve the war's history," Lincoln said.

Lincoln received Ekushey Padak two years ago for his contributions to social service. This year, he has been nominated for Swadhinata Padak, the country's highest civilian honour.

Lincoln informed he had donated his Ekushey Padak money to a trust formed for running the museum. He plans to donate his Swadhinata Padak money too.

"The museum is my child. It will inherit half of my properties, while my son will get the other half," he added. Senior journalist Ahmed Shafi Uddin said, "Awarding Lincoln with the Swadhinata Padak was fitting because he devoted his entire life to serving the masses. Lincoln was unmatched in his proactive approach to taking necessary steps for the people and the country, without waiting for assistance or support."

Still bearing marks

"The collaborators chose the remote Gallowari area to carry out mass killing of Hindu people and freedom fighters. This continued even a few days before Khulna was freed on December 17, 1971," he added.

Gouranga Nandy, a Liberation War researcher and author of 'History of the Liberation War in Greater Khulna District', said, "During the war, no one dared to go to Gallowari area. Those who went there after independence discovered piles of decomposed corpses and skeletons. Many local freedom fighters were tortured and killed at Gallowari."

"Shanti Lata, daughter of Abinash Saha from Damodar Saha Para village in Phultala upazila, organised her college peers to join the Liberation War. But was later captured by Razakars' Nowsher Sheikh, Zahur Sheikh, Sohrab Mollah, Hamizuddin Sheikh, Safi Ghazi, Asmat Ghazi, Alahi Sana, and Moni Sana. They took her to Gallowari, where she was raped and murdered," he added.

Liberation War researcher Amal Kumar Gain, who authored 'Genocide Massacre and Mass Grave Survey: Khulna District', published in 2018, said, "After the liberation of Khulna city, about five truckloads of human skulls and bones were recovered from Gallowari Canal and its vicinity. An estimated 15,000 people were killed at the site."

MEMORIAL LEFT IN NEGLECT
The radio station area in Gallowari is now a part of the Khulna University campus. The place where the radio station building stood now has a two-storey

administrative building of KU.

In 1999, the district administration took an initiative to build 'Khulna Gallowari Independence Memorial'. An open stage was built next to the memorial.

Then in 2007, the district council took initiative to build a modern memorial there, and acquired three acres of khas land for it. Construction began on December 31, 2008.

However, after the main monument was inaugurated in 2011, the rest of the work has not resumed since then.

Visiting the memorial area last week, it was seen that the tiles have been broken in many places. There is no boundary wall around the monument. The whole area has been left unprotected and turned into a hangout place for drug addicts and criminals.

"There are respective railways staffs who are supposed to oversee the rail tracks regularly. However, I didn't see any such activities of railway staffs in my area even once a month," Md Shamsuddin, chairman of Nangalkot upazila, said before the JS committee.

Md Kamal, another eyewitness, said he saw three to four unknown youths fled the accident site leaving a bag sometimes before the accident, adding that those youths might have opened the fish plates of the rail track.

Fazle Karim said the cause of the train accident will be identified and culprits will be nabbed through investigation.
