

NDMC math festival on April 25-27

Notre Dame Math Club (NDMC) will be organising "Bashundhara Presents 4th NDC National Math Festival Powered by Vooter Adda" on April 25-27, said a press release.

The three-day festival will give students the opportunity to participate in a total of 16 individual segments including Math Olympiad, IQ Olympiad, Calculus Mania, Sudoku, Speedcubing, Project Display and many more.

Students can participate in three categories -- Primary (3rd-5th grade), Junior (6th-8th), Secondary (9th-10th and SSC '24 and equivalent candidates), Higher Secondary (11th-12th).

NDMC general secretary Reasat Prottoy said, "This time we are expecting 4,500+ participants from 300+ institutions. Our purpose is to increase interest in mathematics."

Top performers will be awarded crests and books, along with participation certificates, snacks, and other gifts.

Two MPs did not fill out the income section of the affidavits.

Among others, 20 MPs earn from Tk 5 lakh to Tk 25 lakh, 10 earn Tk 25 lakh to Tk 50 lakh, while the income range of five is Tk 50 lakh to Tk 1 crore.

Two AL lawmakers -- Shammi Ahmed (Tk 1.36 crore) and Aparajita Haque (Tk 1.36 crore) -- earn over Tk 1 crore annually.

Of the two JP lawmakers, one has an annual income of less than Tk 5 lakh, and the other earns more than Tk 50 lakh.

Regarding educational qualifications, Shujan said 60 percent of the candidates

are post graduates [two having PhD degrees], while 16 percent obtained honours, eight percent got HSC, 10 percent passed SSC, and six percent have educational qualifications less than SSC.

Speaking at the event, Shujan Secretary Badiul Alam Majumder said reserved seats are important for women's political empowerment, but there is a question of how much empowerment of women is actually taking place.

"If the political empowerment of women were done through women's seats in the true sense, women would have been elected from general

seats later. In most cases, qualification is not the main consideration for the nomination of reserved seats for women. The nominations were given as favours," he said.

In the same accident, two other -- including a child -- were killed and three others injured.

The victims were identified as two-year-old Rubaira Taznim and Shariful Islam, 34, hailing from Trishal upazila, police said.

Md Chand Miah, officer-in-charge of Trishal Police Station, reported that the accident occurred when a Sherpur-bound bus collided head-on with a CNG-run auto-rickshaw at Trishal municipal area.

Salman and Shariful were pronounced dead upon arrival at MMCH, while the condition of the three injured individuals remains critical.

The driver of the bus fled the scene, although police seized the vehicle.

A case was filed with the police station regarding the incident.

Bangladeshi ship hostage with 23 sailors, the pirates contacted the owners. The ship is allegedly anchored near Mozambique.

Foreign Minister Hasan Mahmud said owners are not in favour of military operations on hostage ships.

Regarding food shortage, he said that has not happened in the past when ships were hijacked. Hopefully, it won't happen this time, he added.

Earlier, Mizanul Islam, media adviser of KSRM Group -- the ship's owning group, had said food was still available.

Asked about Nobel Laureate Muhammad Yunus' award from Unesco, Hasan Mahmud said he was surprised that Yunus Centre "falsified" the award.

It is not a Unesco award. There was a conference related to Unesco in Azerbaijan, when an Israeli sculptor provided the award, he said.

He also mentioned a few key challenges, such as inadequate education quality, and a lack of trained teachers impacting quality and the education system's relevance to the job market.

"As a country, we don't have that much in terms of assets. So, whatever we have, we need to utilise on a priority basis."
