Later, a policy discussion was held where Taylor, Festival Director and President of Dhaka Theatre Nasiruddin Yousuff Bachchu and Founder and CEO of IID Sayeed Ahamed, spoke, among others.

Ease visa conditions for workers

State minister calls on UK gov't

UNB, Dhaka

State Minister for Expatriates' Welfare and Overseas Employment Shofiqur Rahman Choudhury has called on the UK government to ease visa conditions for Bangladeshi workers who want to work in hospitality and catering sectors.

He was speaking as a chief guest at a dialogue on Bangladesh hosted by the UK's All-Party Parliamentary Group (APPG) on Thursday.

Bangladesh High Commissioner to the UK Saida Muna Tasneem, Bob Blackman MP, and APPG vice-chair Lord Karan Bilimoria spoke at the event.

APPG on Bangladesh Chair Rushanara Ali MP chaired the dialogue.

The state minister highlighted Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina-led government's ongoing efforts to improve the well-being and welfare of Bangladeshis living around the world, including those in the UK.

He also noted that bilateral relations between Bangladesh and the UK have reached new heights in the last 15 years due. However, he said there are still many areas to be explored to further broaden and deepen the long standing historic relations.

The state minister hoped that the two governments would work together to create more job opportunities for Bangladeshi skilled workers, including restaurant workers, doctors, and nurses.

What Pakistan

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Minister, made the remarks while addressing a press briefing organised at the AL president's political office in the capital's Dhanmondi.

Calling on the BNP leaders to take real lessons from a recent speech made by Pakistani Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif, the AL general secretary said the Pakistani premier feels shame when he sees the progress and height of Bangladesh.

Pakistani Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif lauded the economic development of Bangladesh in his address at a view exchange meeting with the representatives of the business community at the residence of the chief minister of Sindh province in Karachi on Thursday.

Shakib is receiving treatment at Birganj Upazila Health Complex, added the police official.

Cuet to reopen

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"We called a batch meeting tonight (Friday night) to discuss this matter," said Zobaer Ahmed, a third-year student of mechanical engineering department.

Earlier on Thursday, the university authorities announced to suspend all activities including classes and examinations for an indefinite period, and ordered students to vacant halls.

After the announcement, agitated students locked the vice chancellor's office and set fire to two buses which they had confiscated.

On the same night, the students suspended their protest upon assurances from the university authorities that their major demands would be met.

that the current divisions will be resolved soon.

But Dhaka University Professor Emeritus Serajul Islam Choudhury and Mohammad Tanzimuddin Khan, a teacher at International Relations Department of DU, have a different point of view.

They said the entire society is currently affected by depoliticisation, leading talented students to lose interest in politics. Chhatra Union is also affected by this, they observed.

"Student politics is in its final decline. The range of thinking among student leaders is narrowing. The internal divisions are disheartening," Prof Serajul remarked.

Regarding the current Chhatra Union, Tanzimuddin Khan said, "The political philosophy this student body is supposed to practice is not being upheld, distancing it

from its glorious history. The root cause of the crisis is the prevalence of individualistic interests over organisational ones."

Rageeb Nayeem, president of a faction of Chhatra Union, said, "Unity is the only option for leftists worldwide. Those who don't want a united leftist resistance are behind the current division of Chhatra Union."

When asked what the success of Chhatra Union has been in the last five years, he said, "There is no shortcut to success. Besides, what's the measurement of success?"

"We held nationwide protest rallies against rape in 2020, including a long march towards Noakhali, which garnered widespread support. The establishment of anti-sexual harassment cells on campuses stemmed from our 2015 movement. The successful 'Ducusu Chai' movement led

to Ducusu polls after a 29-year hiatus."

"Our activism spans across campuses across Bangladesh. We have members from both public and private universities, as well as from schools and colleges. We are committed to continuing our movement."

Dipok Sil, president of another faction of the Chhatra Union, claimed that the split within the student body is part of a larger conspiracy aimed at weakening the anti-government resistance.

"In the past few years, I have made several attempts to resolve the situation according to our constitution, but unfortunately, they have not been unsuccessful," he added.

He said Chhatra Union continues to play a major role in student movements when compared to other student bodies.

10. OBJECT OF THIS REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST
The present Request for Expression of Interest (REOI) is related to the Services of the ODBM consultancy mentioned above.
The ODBM consultant will bridge the existing gaps by undertaking a range of activities not addressed by the TA team, proceed with the previously mentioned tendering processes, and subsequently offer ongoing on-site technical support for a period of two years.
The scope of services sought is anticipated to encompass the following tasks. These tasks are described merely to give an indication to the Applicants to the ODBM about the content of the assignment, and will be described in further detail and precision in the corresponding Terms of Reference:

- Phase 1 Planning and Improvement:**
Improve Phase 1 (expected to start shortly without ITS on a limited operational basis): Assist in vehicle operator contract monitoring, provide DBRTCL with daily advice for improvement, and define actionable strategies.
- Phase 2 Planning and Implementation:**
Develop a detailed action plan with a timeline, conduct necessary surveys and data collection, analyze optimal technology for bus fleet motorization, and update the operation and financial plans to reduce operational subsidies.
- Procurement Process of ITS systems:**
Facilitate ITS (Intelligence Transport Systems) procurement till system launch, Platform Screen Doors, Ticketing System, Passenger Information, Bus Tracking and Regulation, Security and Surveillance, etc. Define technical specifications, prepare evaluation criteria, analyze bids, assist in negotiations and the mobilization phase, and provide support during the first two years of service.
- BRT Infrastructure Improvements:**
Identify the scope and design priority infrastructure improvements, draft bidding documents, assist in the bidding and contract negotiation process, conduct E&S due diligence, and supervise construction works.
- Depot design:**
Design a new depot or extension of the existing depot, draft tender documents, assist during procurement, and supervise construction works.
- Optional Tranches for Additional Fleet:**
Draft requirements and bidding documents for an additional BRT fleet, assist in procurement, supervise the production and testing phases of the new fleet.
- Operational Support and Capacity Building:**
Support DBRTCL in the first 2 years of O&M, manage contract interfaces, monitor KPIs, and clear payments to service providers. Focus on last mile and first mile connectivity to enhance BRT accessibility and ridership. Conduct capacity building through organizational reviews, staffing support, policy development, intensive staff training, and facilitate knowledge exchange trips for DBRTCL management.
- Project management:**
Establishing objectives, timelines, and milestones; promote efficient allocation of financial, human, and technological resources; risk identification and mitigation; implementing quality control measures; maintaining transparent communication with all stakeholders; overseeing the entire procurement process including tender drafting, contract negotiations, and management; tracking progress against milestones and key performance indicators; ensuring compliance with relevant regulations; managing changes in project scope, resources, or objectives; and finally, ensuring successful project closure, fulfilling all contractual obligations, evaluating outcomes, and documenting lessons learned for future reference.
- Policy Development and Implementation:**
Prepare and implement policies covering maintenance, safety, data privacy, health protocols, security measures, emergency responses, and passenger satisfaction.
- Strategic Development:**
Develop a Bus Industry Restructuring Program to minimize competition between existing and future BRT services. Plan improvements in inter-modality between BRT and other mass transit systems and explore new BRT opportunities within the country.

11. DURATION OF THE MISSION	Project Timeline: The duration of the services is projected to span forty-two (42) months. This includes an initial eighteen (18) months dedicated to studies and the tendering process, followed by twenty-four (24) months of ongoing technical support.
