Prof Mushtaq Hossain, a public health expert and former advisor to the Institute of Epidemiology, Control Research, stressed the importance of shifting focus away from medicinecentric medical care and advocated for a public health movement to demand prescriptions with generic names.

Shikha Ganguly, physician at the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology of Dhaka Medical College Hospital, said doctors support the idea of using generic names in prescriptions.

She emphasised the need for strict adherence to rules by pharmacies, including the presence of registered pharmacists in each outlets.

Experts also prescribing generic using names can potentially healthcare costs competition. promoting reducing out-of-pocket expenses, and empowering consumers to make informed decisions about their medical needs.

They also stressed the importance of ensuring quality control regulatory measures in the pharmaceutical sector to effectively implement this practice.
