



# Illegal sand extraction plagues Dharla, two other rivers

Erosion devours croplands, homes in Patgram, Lalmonirhat

Illegal stone and sand extraction has caused severe erosion in three transboundary rivers — Dharla, Singimari, and Saniajan.

Visiting the river banks in Patgram upazila of Lalmonirhat recently, this correspondent saw sand and stones piled up on the banks after extraction with dredger machines, while large holes were formed on the river beds.

Locals complained that indiscriminate sand extraction is causing riverbank erosion, subsequent flash floods during monsoons, and damage to croplands, homes, biodiversity, and livelihoods.

Dharla is about 31.5 kilometres long on the Bangladesh side, while Singimari is 21km and Saniajan 4km long, according to Bangladesh Water Development Board.

In fiscal year 2017-18, the BWDB completed 4km of excavation and 2.5km of embankment protection works at a cost of Tk 24.72 crore on the rivers, the officials added.

"Dharla's erosion devoured my homestead, 10 bighas of my arable lands, and also the village graveyard. Like me, many others lost everything to the river," said Nazrul Islam, 77, a farmer in Patgram's Rasulganj village.

Many locals have alleged that a section of ruling party leaders are patronising the sand lifters. They are colluding with dishonest officials in the administration to extract sand and stones illegally.

With change of power, the rivers also change hands, but their fate remains unchanged, they said.

Ruhul Amin Babul, general secretary of Patgram upazila AL and also the upazila chairman, said illegal sand lifters are criminals, and their political identity is irrelevant. "They

change their allegiance with the change of power. They don't belong to any political party," he said.

Strict action should be taken against these people, he added.

Shahidul Islam, 65, a farmer from the same village, said,

"At present, some 400-500 dredger machines are being used to lift stones and sand round the clock from the rivers."

Nazir Ali, 78, of Banglabari village, called upon authorities concerned to take strict measures to bring the culprits to book.

Contacted, Abdul Gaffar, upazila agriculture officer in Patgram, said, "Many families who were engaged in agriculture lost their croplands to river erosion. This, in turn, adversely affected the area's agricultural productivity. However, there has

been no survey done on how much arable land was lost to river erosion."

MA Momin, additional deputy commissioner (revenue) of Lalmonirhat and member secretary of the district's National River Protection Committee, said, "The district and upazila administrations are firmly against illegal sand and stone extraction from the rivers."

Shunil Kumar, executive engineer of BWDB in Lalmonirhat, said, "Local administration will take legal action against the culprits. Proposals have been sent to the government for dredging Singimari and Saniajan rivers. For Dharla river, the government will decide on necessary measures."

Nurul Islam, UNO of Patgram upazila, said, "The upazila administration has conducted numerous mobile court drives. Although these illegal activities have mostly stopped, there are reports of some stone lifting at night. Our drives will continue."

When asked about the allegation that some officials are involved in sand lifting, he denied it.



## RMG workers demand wages, Eid bonus by June 10

Bangladesh Garment Sramik Sanghati, an RMG workers' platform, demonstrated in Dhaka yesterday, demanding full salaries with overtime and Eid bonuses by June 10.

They also demanded that the government stop excessive bus fares and ensure safe travel arrangements for garment workers during the Eid journey.

To press home their demands, they brought out a procession from Purana Paltan and later held a rally in front of the Jatiya Press Club in the capital.

Speaking at the event, Taslima Akhter, president of Bangladesh Garment Sramik Sanghati, said nearly 80 percent of Bangladesh's foreign exchange earnings come from the hard work of garment workers, but they face various challenges during the two Eid celebrations every year.

She expressed concern over the common practice of factories failing to pay bonuses on time. Workers have faced mistreatment and abuse when they protest demanding arrears, said Taslima.

The labour leaders said during Eid travel every year, transport fares double and even triple. Garment workers risk their lives by taking low-cost transport to reach home. The government needs to address this issue, they said.

## POLLS CODE VIOLATION 2 BCL leaders jailed, UP chairman fined

A mobile court in Tangail's Mirzapur upazila has sentenced two local leaders of Bangladesh Chhatra League to seven days' imprisonment for violating electoral code of conduct.

They are: Abdullah Al Fahad, senior joint convener of upazila unit of BCL, and Ishad Ahmed Mallick Nishad, former member of Warshi union unit of BCL.

The mobile court of executive magistrate Masudur Rahman, also assistant commissioner (Land) in the upazila, also fined local Warshi Union Parishad Chairman Mahbul Alam Mallick Tk 10,000 over similar charges.

Masudur Rahman caught the convicts red-handed while distributing biryani among people after a meeting on Friday afternoon, ahead of the Mirzapur Upazila Parishad polls slated for June 5.

An altercation ensued between the executive magistrate and the convicts. Informed, Upazila Nirbahi Officer of Mirzapur Sheikh Nurul Amin went to the spot around 8:00pm and ordered the trio to be taken to the UNO office.

Later, around 11:00pm, they were handed down the punishments under Section 32(1) of the Upazila Parishad Election Code of Conducts of 2016. The two BCL men were taken to jail around 1:00am, confirmed Masudur Rahman.

Additional police personnel were deployed as supporters and associates of the convicts gathered at the UNO office premises.

## 3 killed, 5 injured in road accidents

At least three people have been killed and five others injured in accidents in two districts, according to reports from our local correspondents.

In Sirajganj, two people were killed and three others injured as a CNG-run auto-rickshaw and a truck collided in Alokdiar area of Sadar upazila on Friday night.

Mohadeb Shah, 60, of Hat-Pangashi village in Raiganj upazila; and Abu Obaida, 24, of village Muktagarhi in Sirajganj Sadar upazila died on the spot.

Sirajganj Sadar Police Station Officer-in-Charge Md Sirajul Islam said the accident took place around 10:00pm on Friday. The injured were undergoing treatment at Sirajganj 250-bed Bongomata Sheikh Fazilatunnesa Mujib General Hospital.

## Build cold storage facilities in Rangpur region Demand local farmers

The Krishak Sangram Parishad has called for a special allocation in the upcoming national budget to construct cold storage facilities for potatoes and vegetables in the Rangpur region.

This demand was raised at a human chain formed in front of Rangpur Press Club yesterday.

Lawyer Palash Kanti Nag, convener of Krishak Sangram Parishad, addressed the gathering. Speakers said there was an urgent need for cold storage facilities in Rangpur and Dinajpur, pointing out that the lack of such infrastructure results in an annual loss of Tk 10,000 crores due to rotting vegetables. Without adequate cold storage, 30 percent of vegetables produced in this area are wasted yearly.

They said total vegetable demand in the country stands at 1.52 crore tonnes annually. Insufficient government cold storage facilities compel farmers to sell their produce at extremely low prices to avoid spoilage.

Palash Kanti criticised the reduction in agricultural subsidies and allocations in recent budgets, stressing the necessity of ensuring fair prices for farmers. He also demanded interest-free loans on easy terms for farmers.

Following the rally, a procession marched the main road of the city, with participation from marginal-level farmers from various areas of Rangpur city.
