## Over 200 fishing trawlers damaged

Tidal waves and strong winds under the influence of Cyclone Remal damaged more than 200 small and medium fishing trawlers in Barguna's Patharghata.

The trawlers sustained partial and complete damage despite taking shelters in different canals in the upazila during the cyclone. More than 400 fishermen are facing difficulties due to that.

Golam Mostafa Chowdhury, president of district fishery trawler owners' association, and Dulal Hossain, general secretary of district fishing trawler workers' union, confirmed it.

During the cyclone, the big trawlers from the district, which go fishing in the Bay, were anchored at different wharves amid the ongoing 65 day ban on fishing since May 20.

The small and medium-sized trawlers were used in fishing in Bishkhali and Baleshwar rivers and sought shelter in canals during the cyclone, they informed.

The tidal surge and strong winds over a 30-hour long span during and after the cyclone left more than 200 of those trawlers damaged.

"I was along with two others on our small trawler to catch fish near the coast. The trawler got completely damaged in the cyclone, leaving us destitute," said Faruq Hossain, a fisherman from Chhonbunia.

Patharghata UNO Roknuzzaman Khan said, "I will discuss with higher authorities on how to help the affected fishermen."

## FLOOD IN SYLHET Situation improves but many areas still waterlogged

While the rivers in Sylhet continue to flow above the danger level at different points, the flood situation in the district has shown signs of improvement, with water levels in the Surma and Kushiara gradually receding.

Visiting Gowainghat, Companiganj, Kanaighat and Zakiganj upazilas, the most affected areas in the flood caused by downhill runoff of water from the hills, it was seen that the floodwater was receding.

"Between May 27 and May 29, there was more rain than usual due to the influence of Cyclone Remal. Also, there was heavy rain in Cherrapunji of Meghalaya, India on May 30. This resulted in flashflood and a rise in the water levels of the rivers in the district," said Deepak Ranjan Dash, executive engineer of Water Development Board in Sylhet.

"However, since then the rains reduced significantly. Cherrapunji received no rainfall in last 24 hours, and 54mm rain the day before. So, the flood situation is gradually improving. If it



does not rain heavily, the situation will improve further in the next 3-5 days," he added.

According to BWDB sources, Surma river was flowing above 71cm in Kanaighat yesterday, down from 83cm on Saturday, while Kushiara was flowing about 129cm above Amalshid Point yesterday compared to 193cm on Saturday.

Meanwhile, erosion and potholes on different roads have been becoming visible as water receded in some areas, including Raigarh section of Darbast Kanaighat road and Kanaighat Surighat road in Kanaighat upazila, and Gowainghat-Salutikar, Gowainghat Jallong and Radhanagar-Jallong roads in Gowainghat upazila.

Local representatives said numerous mud houses in many villages collapsed, fish got washed away from ponds, and the crops were damaged in inundated fields due to flood.

"Upazila level officials of different departments concerned are on the ground in flood affected and risky areas. Residents are being warned to safely evacuate their homes, markets and shops in flood-prone areas. A total of 56 shelters are ready in 13 unions of the upazila," said Md Towhidul Islam, UNO of Gowainghat upazila.

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# Sundarbans: no time to heal between cyclones

Remal claims 138 animal lives, causes infrastructural damages, contaminates ponds

In 2007, Cyclone Sidr ripped through the Sundarbans, the world's largest mangrove forest. The forest took the brunt of the storm, saving human lives by slowing down its destructive force.

However, it paid a heavy price. One-fourth of the forest area was damaged, with 8-10 percent completely destroyed and 15 percent partially damaged. Infrastructure within the Sundarbans was severely impacted, with offices, communication towers, and watercraft destroyed. Wildlife suffered immensely, with loss of habitat, displacement, and scarcity of food and water.



Two years later, Cyclone Aila struck. Around 40 percent of the forest's vegetation was destroyed, and 30-35 percent of the mangrove cover was damaged. The impact on wildlife was devastating, with endangered species such as tigers facing habitat disruption and food scarcity.

The Sundarbans continued to face the wrath of cyclones

like Bulbul and Amphan. Each time the forest began to recover, another cyclone hit.

Then came cyclone Remal. Trees were uprooted, and a 10-12 ft tidal surge submerged the forest for nearly two days.

As the water recedes, the full extent of the damage is becoming clear. Carcasses are being recovered while the forest floor is littered with uprooted trees.

The Sundarbans is already grappling with the negative

impacts of climate change, including rising salinity and extreme weather events like cyclones.

Given the repeated battering by cyclones and the ongoing effects of climate change, experts wonder how long it will take for the Sundarbans to recover. The answer? Maybe decades.

And before it fully recovers, there might be another cyclone waiting to strike... maybe next year or the year after.

### DAMAGE TO WILDLIFE

According to the forest department, a total of 138 animals were found dead, including 134 deer and 4 wild boars. Additionally, 18 deer and one python were rescued and released back into the forest.

Experts said the actual number of dead animals could be higher. Countless wildlife, particularly deer, boars, snakes, and monitor
