CMCH to get specialised burn unit soon

A longstanding demand for a specialised and modern burn unit in Chattogram is finally being addressed. The National Economic Council approved a Tk 284.76 crore project on May 9 to construct a specialised burn and plastic surgery unit at Chattogram Medical College Hospital.

The project, funded jointly by the Bangladesh and China, with contributions of Tk 104.93 crore and Tk 179.83 crore respectively, is set to be completed by June 2026.

Rajib Palit, deputy director of CMCH, said the project will start soon.

On February 24, nine individuals sustained burn injuries following a gas cylinder explosion at the Rohingya camp in Noakhali's Bhashan Char. Among them, three-year-old Russell succumbed to his injuries due to the lack of Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and High Dependency Unit (HDU) facilities at the burn unit.

Such incidents are not uncommon in CMCH, so the project to upgrade the burn unit has been a welcome development.

Dr Rafiq Uddin Ahmed, head of the Burn and Plastic Surgery Unit at CMCH, emphasised the inadequacy of the current the health minister, he said.

30-bed unit. "The existing facilities are insufficient to accommodate the patients," he said. "It is a crying need to make the CMCH burn unit well equipped with adequate facilities to treat burn patients from across Chattogram division."

The new 150-bed unit will include outpatient and indoor departments, an



emergency department, 10 ICU beds, 20 HDU beds for male and female patients, and five HDU beds for children.

CMCH director Brig Gen Taslim Uddin said the feasibility study has been completed and the construction work is expected to begin in August.

A Chinese delegation is scheduled to visit for a meeting on June 8 to discuss the primary design of the building with

Invitation to a Market Assessment Conference for Improvement of Urban Public Health Preventive Services Project (LGD Component)

The Government of Bangladesh has signed a Financing Agreement with International Development Association (IDA) for financing US\$200 million for Urban Health, Nutrition and Population Project. The Project will be implemented by two implementing agencies: - (1) Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, and (2) Ministry of Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives. The Local Government Division (LGD) under the Ministry of Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives will implement the "Improvement of Urban Public Health Preventive Services Project" with the help of IDA financing of US\$ 100 million. The main goal of the project is to develop appropriate systems and capacities of LGD, City Corporations and Municipalities for delivering public health preventive services such as vector (mosquito) management and control, outhouse medical waste management, mitigating air and sound pollution in city life and climate change effects on public health, behavior change communications to promote healthy lifestyles and creating awareness as well as community-driven interventions for addressing Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs).

Under the project, the implementing agency (LGD) will procure goods and services to achieve the above goal. The major procurement items are: (i) equipment for establishment of a biological laboratory (main laboratory and training laboratory) for vector analysis and management including an insectarium; (ii) equipment and testing materials/chemicals for public health laboratory (i.e., food testing laboratory); (iii) equipment for vector (mosquito) management, collection of adult mosquitoes and control; (iv) equipment for air and sound pollution detection and control; (v) personal protection equipment; (vi) Insecticide/pesticide for vector control; (vii) 1 incinerator, 1 autoclave and 1 chemical treatment plants (1set); (viii) ICT/MIS equipment (such as: computer, laptop, printer, main server, backup server); (ix) office furniture; (x) Service provider for outhouse medical waste management; (xi) training firms for arranging foreign and local training/tours; and (xii) study/research on mosquito biology and research on dengue vaccine.

Procurement under the project will be carried out in accordance with the World Bank Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers, November 2020 (the "WB Procurement Regulations") and the provisions stipulated in the Legal Agreement, Project Procurement Strategy for Development (PPSD) and the procurement plan. The project will be subject to the World Bank's Anticorruption Guidelines, dated October 15, 2006, and revised in January 2011 and July 2016. The evaluation of bids/proposals and contract signing procedure shall follow the Public Procurement Rules, 2008 of Bangladesh and the WB Procurement Regulations.

It is planned that the procurement of large packages for goods and services for the project will commence very soon. As part of designing a fit-for-purpose Project Procurement Strategy for Development (PPSD), the LGD proposes to conduct market engagement to understand market context and get the right suppliers/ service providers.
