There will be challenges in achieving the revenue target set for the upcoming fiscal year, said Snehasish Barua, a chartered accountant.

Bangladesh Bank yesterday asked banks to ensure the availability of cash in automated teller machines (ATMs) during the Eid-ul-Azha holidays.

Banks will have to deliver ondemand financial services through ATMs, points of sale (POS), internet

banking and mobile financial services (MFS), said a central bank notice.

The central bank notice said if any ATM faces a technical glitch, the respective bank must have it up and running in the quickest possible time. The banking regulator also asked

banks to ensure POS service during the holidays and to use awareness programmes to keep clients alert

so that they can avert fraudulent

Banks will have to ensure the use of the two-factor authentication system as a security tool for clients settling transactions through online banking.
