Finally ending all uncertainty, almost all intended pilgrims have gone to Saudi Arabia to perform the hajj this year.

Through the operation of the last hajj flights of Flynas from Dhaka airport around 6:00pm yesterday, the outgoing hajj flight operation of this year came to an

The month-long flight operation began on May 9.

This year, a total of 85,180 Bangladeshis were registered to perform hajj. Of them, 85,113 have gone to Saudi Arabia through 217 flights of Biman, Saudia and Flynas, said Abdul Maleq, assistant hajj officer at the Hajj Office.

Of the total pilgrims, 4,482 people went to Saudi Arabia under the government hajj management.

Police arrested two people so far, said Mazharul Amin, officerin-charge of Basail Police Station.

Residents Uttarpara Dakkhinpara in Kashil union engaged in the conflict around 10:00am, using lethal weapons, said police and witnesses.

Additional personnel were deployed in the area to bring the situation under control.

Among the injured, ten people from Uttarpara and five from Dakkhinpara were admitted to Tangail General Hospital.

Of them, two individuals from Uttarpara -- Minhaj Uddin, 37, and Billal, 55 were transferred to Dhaka, said Aigur Rahman, incharge of the hospital police box. The OC said no one filed any case yet.

significantly one to two days before Eid when most service workers leave Dhaka, he said.

Since buses departing Dhaka for Eid trips often cannot return on time, local buses exploit this situation to coerce workers into taking these local buses to reach their village homes, he said.

Acknowledging stopping these local buses is often difficult, Munibur. however, mentioned that video cases can be filed against such buses, allowing for later strict action.

He also said vehicles transporting cattle must go to city corporationapproved markets and or unload the animals within the market premises, not on the roads, he added.

Cattle-carrying vehicles must display a sticker banner indicating the designated market to make sure that those are given priority and avoid harassment, he said.

Watch towers have been set up at all cattle markets in the capital to monitor the overall situation, he added.


