Water hyacinth clogs canal

Locals suffer as boat service disrupted

Residents in Barguna's Taltali upazila are struggling to commute as boat services on Kachupatra Canal have remained halted since May 26, due to water hyacinth.

The 300-foot-wide, 50-kilometre-long canal used to connect Payra and Andharmanik rivers, while flowing through Amtali and Taltali, until it became a closed waterbody, with embankments built on both ends around 20 years back, said locals.

Due to lack of water flow, there is often an overgrowth of water hyacinths in the canal. During the dry season, locals remove hyacinths to allow movement of boats at Betmore Kheya-ghat in Badurgachha area of Sharikkhali union.



Locals said people from around 10 villages in the area, including more than 200 students, use the boat service to commute to neighbouring Chakamaia union.

With boat service halted, locals now have to travel an extra 20-25km and spend Tk 100-150 more to reach Kalapara town," said Abdul Barek, a local.

"A permanent bridge would reduce our suffering," he

Mansura Akhtar, a fifth grader, said, "We have no school in our village, so we cross the canal using boats to attend Chakamaia Government Primary School. Now, we are struggling to attend classes on time."

Farooq Khan, chairman of Sharikkhali Union Parishad, said, "The canal is too wide for a bamboo bridge. So, boats were the only means to cross the canal."

Contacted, Sifat Anayar Tumpa, UNO of Taltali upazila, said the local UP chairman has been asked to take steps to remove water hyacinths from the canal to resume boat services. "Arrangements will be made regarding construction of a bridge after discussion with authorities later." she added.



Century-old school at landslide risk

The KB Ehia Government classes. Primary School in Juri upazila of Moulvibazar is at risk of a landslide happening at any moment from a neighbouring hillock amid monsoon.

Mud and water are already sliding down the hillock, falling and accumulating on the roof of the school building.

Amid risk of further damage,

academic activities at the school are in jeopardy.

According to school authorities, a hillock of around 30-40 feet tall is located just beside the one-storey school building on the east side. A lot of mud and soil has already collapsed on and around the building since heavy rains began earlier this month.

The school, established in 1921, was closed during that time due to Eid-ul-Azha and summer holidays. However, once the school reopens after July 2, its 306 students and headteacher of the school, said the eight teachers will be subject to building on the east side is at most

Locals have expressed concern over the safety of the students. "We were gripped by fear while

attending classes before the vacation, when soil and mud started falling down the hillock beside



the school. Many of my classmates stopped coming to school over fear of a landslide," said Raihan Ahmed,

the risk of a landslide happening risk. It is already in a dilapidated state, as plasters are often falling while rainwater accumulates on the roof and leaks inside. Classes are held in one of its rooms, while the other is used as a teachers' room. In case of a landslide, the entire building is likely to collapse.

"Eid-ul-Azha" and summer vacation started from June 13 and will end on July 2. We are worried because after school reopens, we would have to conduct academic activities amid the risk of landslides if there is heavy rainfall again. We informed the upazila primary education officer in this regard," she added.

Khandkar Abul Bashar, president of the school's managing committee, demanded construction of a strong wall behind the school building to prevent landslides from damaging it.

Contacted, Dilipmoy Dash Chowdhury, primary education officer in Juri upazila, said he is aware about the matter and has informed higher authorities.


