

Javed Muneer re-elected NSU trustee board chair

the killing. Amanullah promised substantial financial support and arranged their passports, visas, and tickets to Kolkata, said the probe report.

Foysal and Mostafiz, both truck drivers by profession, did not have passports. Siam, Aktaruzzaman's associate, confirmed payment for their passports and coordinated the entire process.

According to Mostafiz, they traveled from Khulna to Dhaka on April 15 to obtain Indian visas urgently.

After securing medical visas, they travelled to Khulna on April 25 and then to Kolkata on May 2, staying at a residential hotel.

On May 10, Mostafiz went to the New Town flat in Kolkata. He, alongside

Jihad, Foysal, Mostafiz, and other members killed the lawmaker in the flat afterwards, according to the report.

Mostafiz and Foysal returned to Bangladesh on May 19 and visited Aktaruzzaman's flat.

They went into hiding after the victim's family filed a case with Sher-E-Bangla Nagar police, and Amanullah was arrested.

On June 26 evening, the two suspects were arrested from a temple in Chattogram's Sitakunda. They are on a six-day remand in DB custody.

DB chief Harun Or Rashid, also an additional commissioner of the DMP, said to dodge the eyes of law enforcers, they started working as cooks at the temple.

"Foysal and Mostafiz are the followers of Amanullah, a leader of outlawed Purbo

Banglar Communist Party. They worked as two main associates for Amanullah in the murder of the MP," he said, adding that the two were involved in different criminal activities on Amanullah's instructions.

During interrogation, they said the passports were kept at Aktaruzzaman's Bashundhara residence. Cops recovered the passports from under a mattress during a raid at the flat on June 29, as detailed in the investigation report.

Five individuals have confessed to the murder so far.

They are: Amanullah, his nephew Tanvir Bhuiyan, Aktaruzzaman's friend Celesty Rahman, and Kazi Kamal Babu, Jhenaidah AL's relief secretary.

Foysal remains in custody, while Saidul Karim Mintu, Jhenaidah AL's general secretary, is in jail.

Maasranga Television, and his wife Meherun Runi, a senior reporter at ATN Bangla, were killed in the early hours of February 11, 2012, at their rented flat in the capital's West Rajabazar.

"The investigation into the Sagar Rumi murder case has not yet been completed even after 12 years, as such, its trial has not seen the light of day yet. Unfortunately, this case has been

continuously ridiculing our criminal justice system and damaging it to an irreparable stage, which was remedied to some extent by the Bangabandhu murder case and the cases before the International Crime Tribunals," the HC bench of Justice Sheikh Hassan Arif and Justice Md Bazlur Rahman said in the 65-page verdict released yesterday.

On May 13 this year, the HC bench delivered the verdict following a petition

filed by three death-row convicts on August 31, 2021, challenging the legality of confining them to death cells before attaining the finality of their sentence.

In the full text of the verdict released yesterday, the HC directed the authorities concerned to start immediate arrangements for shifting the prisoners from death cells to ordinary prisons and complete the process within two years.

around 2:30pm and marched from Nilkhet to Katabon intersection, before reaching Shahbagh.

Police were stationed in anticipation of their arrival. During the protest, students made a four-point demand, including reinstatement of the 2018 notification and merit-based recruitment.

Similarly, students from Jahangirnagar University, Barisal University, Jagannath University, Chittagong University, and Islamic University, Kustitia brought out processions and held rallies in and around their campuses.

Meanwhile, Bangladesh Muktijoddha Sontan Sangsad also made their stance clear, advocating for the preservation of the 30 percent quota for children of freedom fighters.

They made a seven-point demand in front of the Raju Sculpture around 10:30am.

"Since university students are unhappy with the 30 percent quota for the children of freedom fighters, the government can consider how it can be decreased to a more acceptable level," said Solaiman Mia, chairman of the platform.

Haor and adjoining areas, with villages appearing as a vast water body when this correspondent was on his way to Murshibadkura village by boat.

To make things worse, waves from the haor are hitting the waterlogged houses, washing away soil from the bases and weakening the foundations further.

Residents were trying to protect their houses from the waves with bamboo, pieces of corrugated iron sheets, and water hyacinths.

The fear of snakes looms large at night.

"I have two daughters, and 5-6 cattle. It is difficult to navigate the waterlogged

surroundings to reach the shelters. So I remained home, even though we are essentially trapped inside for three weeks. The flood situation keeps worsening," said Husna Begum, a resident of Murshibadkura village.

"No help has reached us yet. We are struggling to survive," she added.

Kamrul Islam, a fisherman from the same area, said the flood this year has been a big blow.

"We have not recovered yet from the damage caused by the 2022 flood. This year, the storm caused a lot of damage to the house. Then the flood has left us reeling. We are spending sleepless

nights in fear of waves and snakes.

Somehow, I am putting food on the plate for the family by catching fish. No one can understand the difficulty poor people like us are going through," he said.

Fokhor Uddin of Baramaidan village said, "Our house got significantly damaged in the flood. It will take a lot of money to fix the house once the flood recedes."

Najratun Naeem, UNO of Barlekha upazila, said, "We have sufficient stock of food grains. Instructions have been given to ensure that no flood-affected person is left out of relief supplies."

Her brother filed a case with Savar Model Police Station the following day.

CID investigated for over four years, arresting three suspects but ultimately sought their exemption in a final report.

The case was then assigned to the PBI. PBI's investigation

into the murder revealed crucial evidence: a broken switchboard and a bloodstain hand mark on the wall.

"During investigation, we found out the victim was stabbed before electrocution," said Kudrat-e Khuda, PBI Dhaka district special superintendent.

The accused, Shubol, confessed to his involvement, citing affair with Selima's elder daughter, Poppy, as motive, he added.

Elora Khan Majlish, younger daughter of the victim, said, "My sister even accompanied us to the Prime Minister's Office seeking justice. We never imagined she could kill our mother."

work. She emphasised completing preliminary paperwork now to ensure full-scale project implementation after September."

Senior Secretary of the Planning Division, Satyajit Karmakar, echoed the PM's concerns, noting an expected rise in rainfall and river water levels, suggesting a heightened risk of flooding in August nationwide.

Karmakar said the PM directed civil and field administrations to prepare adequately to mitigate flood impacts and protect citizens.

During the meeting, 11 projects were approved, with a combined estimated cost of Tk 5,459.87 crore.

Of this amount, Tk 5,214.34 crore will be funded by the Bangladeshi government, Tk 140.44 crore from project assistance, and Tk 105.09 crore from organisational funds.

Among the approved projects, seven are new initiatives, while four involve revisions.

"Patilbari Primary School had to be relocated three times in the past year due to erosion," said Mahbubur Rahman, headteacher of the school in Saghata upazila of Gaibandha.

Abdul Malek, headteacher of the school in Gaibandha's Sundarganj upazila, said, "Bhati Borail Govt Primary School has been vulnerable to Teesta's erosion over the past one and half years. We have continuously contacted the LGED department for relocation. Recently, the school has been relocated."

Authorities of Gujimari and Khamar Damarhat government primary schools in Kurigram's Ulipur did the same.

"Kurigram saw the most schools damaged in floods and erosion in the division, affecting at least 1,300 students," said Md Amir Hossain, primary education officer in Ulipur upazila.

Contacted, Muzahidul Islam, deputy director of Primary Education Department in Rangpur, said they are working on alternative measures to compensate for the academic losses.
