Expat stabbed to death in Jashore

A woman was stabbed to death allegedly by a group of robbers at her residence in Jashore's Jhikargachha upazila early yesterday.

The deceased is Ferdousi Begum, 42, wife of Altaf Hossain. She is an expatriate who returned from Spain about a year ago with her family for her son's wedding, said Nishat Al Nahian, additional superintendent (Navaran circle) of police in Jashore.

Altaf had returned to Spain after the wedding, while Ferdousi and her 12-year-old daughter stayed back.

According to police and relatives, some robbers had entered their house through the kitchen window around Sensing their presence, Ferdousi confronted them. The

robbers attacked Ferdousi, stabbing her multiple times. She died on the spot. They also attacked Jannatul with sharp weapons,

leaving her critically injured. She was taken to Jashore

General Hospital. "The robbers have taken some gold ornaments and other valuables. We are trying to identify and arrest them," the officer added.

A Brahmanbaria court yesterday sent two union parishad members to jail in a case filed for allegedly torturing a 25-year-old woman in an arbitration over a theft charge in Brahmanbaria's Bijoynagar upazila.

They are Ishaq Molla, a member of Ward 6 of Bishnupur Union, and Hossain Miah, a former member of Ward 8 of the same union.

Hasan Jamil Khan, inspector (investigation) of Bijoynagar Police Station, said the two were arrested from Bishnupur village on Saturday night after a video of beating a woman went viral on social media.

Jamil said a few days ago, a village police's wife was accused of theft and beaten up by some people, including Ishaq and Hossain.

As the video spread on social media, police detained former and present UP members, said the police official.


Two persons died in accidents on Dhaka-Tangail highway in Gazipur's Kaliakoir yesterday.

A man died after his motorcycle collided with a bus in the upazila's Sutrapur area around 9:00am.

The deceased is Jihan Farhad, 45, of Samantapur in Gazipur, said Shahadat Hossain, officer-in-charge of Nawjor Highway Police Station.

Meanwhile, the driver of a covered van died after he lost control over the steering and ploughed into a food cart in the upazila's Nawjor area around 2:00pm.

Two others, a woman aged around 38 and a child aged seven, were injured. The deceased and the injured could not be identified immediately, said OC Abu Siddique of Basan Police Station.

A section of local influential people allegedly grabbed a portion Mahendranagar Canal on government's land in Nakhenda area of Kurigram's Rajarhat upazila for a fish farming project.

The canal flows through 8-9 bighas of land owned by Railway and Bangladesh Water Development Board, adjacent to the Teesta-Kurigram rail route, and falls into the Teesta river. It is a source of water for irrigation on more than 1,000 acres of agricultural lands in Nakhenda area.


