attempted to leave the college for lunch, JCD members allegedly assaulted them.

Later, at 1:00pm, Rajshahi city BNP senior joint convener Nazmul Huda, along with Limon and other party leaders, entered the principal's office and pressured her to resign.

This correspondent was present in the principal's

room from 12:45pm to 1:45pm.

Despite initially resisting, Prof Amina ultimately signed the resignation paper at 1:30pm after JCD men allegedly ousted her husband from the office and attempted to pick up her son.

Prof Amina said she became the principal based on her own merit and felt she had no choice but to resign to protect her family.

also instructed the unit officials to remain on alert so that no unwanted incidents can take place.

Rezaul Karim, deputy inspector general (operations) of the PHQ, said, "There is no specific threat or risk centring August 15, but police will remain on high alert to avert any kind of unwanted incidents."

On August 10, three officers, a junior commissioned officer, and five other army personnel were injured when protesters attacked army patrol teams with sharp weapons at Gopinathpur of Gopalganj Sadar.

According to a press release sent by the Inter-

Services Public Relations Directorate (ISPR), two patrol teams of the army went to the spot after protesters blocked the Gopalganj Dhaka highway.

The teams were attacked with locally made weapons, it said. The protesters also hurled brick chunks at the teams. An army vehicle was set alight and another two were vandalised.

According to the ISPR, the army patrol team fired four shots to disperse the protesters and bring the situation under control.

Additional troops have been deployed in the area, it said, adding that the injured army personnel were out of danger and undergoing treatment.

Mayor Khaleque's six-storey residence in ward 22 was seen completely destroyed.

Shaukat Ali, a KCC employee, said, "The mayor has not returned yet. All the belongings have been looted. Only debris remains."

Lashkar Tajul Islam, chief executive officer of KCC, acknowledged that city dwellers have been facing significant challenges due to the suspension of KCC services in the absence of the mayor and councillors.

"We are exploring different ways to keep the councillors' offices operational," he added.

I did not have any other way but to resign as a BNP and Chhatra Dal men attempted to beat my husband and son," she said.

When contacted, BNP leader Nazmul Huda claimed he went to the campus as a "non-political person" to resolve the issue and ensure Prof Amina's safety.

JCD leader Emdadul Haque did not respond to repeated phone calls from this correspondent.

Gabtoli. While I got my sister back, I haven't seen my mother since. I demand that the current interim government return my mother immediately," Sajed said.

Nazma Akter, another protester, said, "My husband was taken away in front of me on March 27, 2019. Since then, I have gone to many places, but to no avail. The police did not even accept my report of my husband's disappearance."

Nazma's husband, Sujan Mia, a BNP leader, disappeared without a trace, and her efforts to find him have been met with silence.

"I want my husband back. If he is dead, I want to know that too. At the same time, I demand justice for those who took my husband," she added.

Sajedul Kabir Sajel from Cox's Bazar also joined the gathering, holding onto a memory that continues to haunt him.

His mother, Rezia Begum Revy, and his 12-year-old sister, Afsana Nuri Alia, were taken on April 16, 2019 from Narayanganj, returned to a friend's house in Chattogram.

## ANTI-GOVT PROTEST One more dies of bullet wounds

Shah Alam, a 40-year-old garment worker, who was shot after law enforcers opened fire on anti-government protesters on July 19 has died while undergoing treatment.

He passed away around 3:00am on Monday in the ICU of the burn unit at Dhaka Medical College Hospital,

according to Md Bachchu Mia, in charge of the hospital's police camp.

The body was handed over to his family without an autopsy.

Shah Alam, originally from Anantapur village in Homna upazila, Cumilla, lived in a rented house on Wapda Road, Rampura, with his wife, Shipi Akther, and their three children. His father's name is Renu Mia.

According to his younger brother, Abu Taher, Alam was shot on July 19 while returning home from work when law enforcers fired at protesters.

The bullet pierced his chest, damaging his lung, and he was admitted to DMCH in critical condition.
