Reform the state, punish criminals

Say speakers at Shujan event STAFF CORRESPONDENT

Shushashoner Jonno Nagorik (Shujan), a civil society platform, yesterday demanded that the interim government build a democratic, noncommunal and human state through reforms.

In a human chain at the capital's Manik Mia Avenue, they urged that steps be taken against those involved in the recent attacks on minority communities across the country.

They also demanded that compensation be provided to the families of those who died during the recent protests and that medical expenses be given to the injured.

Badiul Alam Majumdar, secretary of Shujan, said, "The interim government has to work with two issues simultaneously. One is to bring those who were involved in corruption, mischief, killings and other criminal activities in the past to justice, while the second is to take necessary steps for reforming the state."

He said the current opportunity to reform the state shouldn't be wasted.

In the programme, Robaet Ferdous, a professor of Dhaka University, said, "Proper steps must be taken to bring back all the money laundered out of the

victims of the ongoing flood and donate to the Chief Adviser's relief fund," said Dr Tofail Ahmed, Shujan's executive member, said, "Everyone, particularly those who are well-off, should extend their hands to the victims of the ongoing flood and donate to the Chief Adviser's relief fund."

He also urged everyone to remain cautious of propagandas regarding Bangladesh from foreign media outlets.

In a press release, Shujan also urged that the election commission be reformed with honest, eligibe and impartial individuals, and that repressive laws like the Cyber Security Act should be removed. They also recommended holding students' union elections at the educational

NSU chairman urges govt to uphold current board STAFF CORRESPONDENT

Javed Muneer Ahmad, chairman of the reconstituted North South University trustee board, urged the government to protect the current management of NSU.

His statement comes as tensions rise due to a conflict among trustees after the High Court ordered the reinstatement of the previous board on August 21.

Javed criticised the High Court's decision, calling it "highly abnormal" as the order was issued without hearing the respondents and without representation from the Attorney General's office. He urged the Attorney General to be present at the August 27 hearing in the Chief Justice's court.

The previous board included five trustees facing an Anti-Corruption Commission case involving Tk 304 crore in alleged irregularities.

They are: Azim Uddin Mohammed Ahmed, Shajahan, Benajir Ahmed, MA Kashem and Rehana Rahman.

In 2022, President Hamid reconstituted the board, reducing its members from 16 to 12 after a UGC probe found some members involved in anti-state activities, militancy sponsorship, and corruption.

Police arrested Dhaka-13 Awami League lawmaker Sadek Khan in the West Nakhalpara area of the capital yesterday, in a case filed for killing a trucker Sujan, 24, on July 20 during

Victim's brother Rafiqul Islam filed the case with Mohammadpur Police Station on August 22.

Sadek was arrested in the case, according to a text message sent by the Dhaka Metropolitan Police.

In the FIR, Sadek Khan was named as the 21st accused out of 79 named including the former prime minister Sheikh Hasina.

Some student protesters informed Uzzal about Selim's death around 3:30pm.

labeling them "razakars". Fearing for their safety, Mannan did not return to Dhaka until Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina was forced to step down and flee the country.

Mahfuzur's classmate, Atiq Raihan, remembered him as an individual driven by a sense of justice. "Mahfuzur joined the protest to stand against injustice," Atiq said, adding that he and other students demanded that a playground in their area be named after Mahfuzur to

290 medical teams deployed

for 24 hours, around 2.6 lakh people in Chattogram flood water, according to from the relief teams." officials of Chattogram District Administration.

According to local sources, the district health staffers were supplying water purification tablets (WPT) and oral saline (ORS) to the people affected by flood in the upazilas, but many of them feared that out due to high demand.

"Almost all the tube wells in Narayanhat union in Fatickchȟari upazila have gone under water, while most of the ponds were also submerged by flood water," said Abdul

Halim, a resident in the union, adding, "We have many of the flood affected received oral saline and district were stranded in water purification tablets

> However, officials of the district civil surgeon office assured that there was sufficient stock of WPT and ORS, so people should not panic. Chattogram District

Civil Surgeon Dr Ilias Chowdhury said, "We have sufficient stock of WPT and these supplies would run ORS to combat the present situation and we have already sent requisition for more supplies."

Asked about the stock, he said at present there are 1.11 lakh pieces of WPT and 3.48 lakh packets of ORS in stock in the district.

According to experts, people would likely suffer from various water-borne diseases diarrhoea, dysentery and jaundice.

Contacted, Aniruddha Ghosh, professor of Medicine at Chittagong Medical College, said people in the flood affected areas are vulnerable to many diseases. Infants, young children and elderly people are the most vulnerable groups.

"So, they will need immediate medical care,' he also said. "Their drinking water
