

## Asiatic 3Sixty supports flood relief efforts

The Asiatic 3Sixty family has come together to support those affected by the recent floods, contributing one day's salary to a relief fund, said a press release.

This effort was further amplified by matching contributions from the organisations under the Asiatic 3Sixty umbrella, effectively doubling the total amount collected.

The full donation has been handed over to the Chief Adviser's Relief Fund of the interim government. This fund will be used to provide essential supplies such as food, clean water, medical assistance, and other critical support to flood victims.

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those? I want to surrender and hand over the remaining work to KCC authorities to prevent further losses," he said.

Echoing him, Ziaul Ahsan Titu, proprietor of Ziaul Traders and also councillor of ward 28, said, "My safety is my first priority now. My materials and equipment have been looted from the work site already. However, if I get security from the

authorities, I will complete the remaining work in time." Visiting at least seven wards including 21, 25, 28, and 9, this correspondent observed that sand, stones and other materials were left scattered on road near the construction sites. Only a few workers were seen on some sites.

Kudrat-e-Khuda, president of Sanak Khulna unit, called upon the KCC authorities to restore public

confidence by addressing the issue and finding a way to resume the works of these crucial projects immediately, alongside ensuring transparency and accountability, and steps to prevent future disruptions.

Contacted, Moshuazzaman Khan, chief engineer of KCC, said work has already resumed on 11 project sites while steps are on to resume the rest.

## Menon, Inu

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In the case, the complainant alleged that some of the accused as per instruction directly or indirectly from some others opened fire while hundreds of students, including Rubel, were protesting in Adabor on August 5.

Rubel succumbed to bullet wounds at a hospital two days later, the case said.

Another Dhaka court placed Hasanul Haq Inu on a seven-day remand in the Abdul Wadud murder case.

Dhaka Metropolitan Magistrate Md Ali Haider passed the order after police produced him with a 10-day remand prayer, court sources said.

On August 21, Abdur Rahman, the victim's brother-in-law, filed the case with New Market Police Station against former prime minister Sheikh Hasina and 129 others.

Besides this case, Inu has been accused in several other cases after Hasina resigned and fled on August 5 in the face of a mass uprising.

Meanwhile, in the courtroom, a group of pro-BNP lawyers hurled epithets and attempted to attack Inu and Menon. Some unruly lawyers even threw eggs at them despite law enforcers' presence.

## 70 indigenous families attacked

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The student leaders called on the government to restore the damaged sculpture.

Specific incidents highlighted during the press conference include the torching and looting of homes in Pipalla village, Biral upazila, and Birganj upazila in Dinajpur, leaving many residents displaced out of fear.

In Bochaganj, 12 bighas of land belonging to the

indigenous communities were seized, and in Parbatipur upazila, houses were occupied after being set on fire.

Further attacks were reported in Ranisankail upazila of Thakurgaon, where four houses were burned down.

In Godagari upazila of Rajshahi, several villages were targeted, with valuables worth Tk 10 lakh looted. Similar

incidents occurred in Chapainawabganj Sadar upazila, where fish from several ponds were looted, and in Patnitola upazila of Naogaon, where shops owned by indigenous families were ransacked.

The students at the press conference demanded a thorough investigation into the attacks and immediate government action to protect the affected communities.

## Release detained

well-wishers not to come and exchange greetings with flowers and other stuff, as the country is going through a crisis, said sources at his office.

"The context of my taking charge is a bit different. The blood of the martyrs has not yet dried. Many students are screaming in pain. On the other hand, millions of people are living in dire straits due to the current flood situation in the country. As part of our sympathy to all of them, we request you refrain from any lavish arrangements, including flowers, at this time," Professor Niaz said.

A circular from the education ministry yesterday announced that President Md Shahabuddin, as chancellor of the university, appointed him under the Dhaka University Order, 1973.

He replaced Prof ASM Maksud Kamal, who resigned from the post of DU VC on August 10.

Prof Niaz was the former chairman of the Department of Development Studies at DU. He also was a pro-vice chancellor at Independent University, Bangladesh.

He has a distinguished career in academia and development management. He holds a PhD degree with distinction from the University of Wales Swansea and has earned numerous scholarships, including the UK Commonwealth Scholarship.

He subsequently pursued postdoctoral research at the University of Oxford, University College Swansea, and Asian Institute of Technology.

Prof Niaz also served as the Bangladesh Country Representative of the International Union for Conservation of Nature.

accused attacked the police station and beat up police personnel.

A few law enforcers sheltered in many areas, but the attackers dragged them back to the police station and mercilessly beat them to death.

At least 15 police personnel were killed during

the attack. Thirteen died on the spot, and two others died in hospital. Attackers also vandalised and torched the police station.

Enayetpur Police Station Officer-in-Charge Hasibullah Hasib said they have recorded the case and are investigating it.

"Police are trying to nab the culprits," he said.

## HC scraps petition

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Supreme Court lawyer Kamrul Hasan submitted the petition as a public interest litigation on August 20.

In the petition, he also requested the HC to form an inquiry committee to identify those responsible for formulating the "wrong curriculum" and to suspend the current

curriculum.

"There are lots of errors in the curriculum and syllabus of secondary level education and the student's guardians have reportedly expressed concern with this issue," Kamrul Hasan told The Daily Star.

He also said he will again move the same petition before the HC later.
