



Kamala Harris slams Trump over reproductive rights

Kamala Harris slammed her White House rival Donald Trump's "lies" over reproductive rights Sunday, as both candidates sought an edge in the final month of a deadlocked US presidential election.

Polls have the Republican and Democratic candidates neck and neck, fuelling a high-cost, high-intensity scramble for each and every wavering voter in the seven key states that are likely to decide the outcome on November 5.

In her bid to reach those voters, the vice president is taking to the airwaves in the coming week with a host of television, radio and podcast appearances.

She began her media flurry with an appearance Sunday on the podcast "Call Her Daddy" -- one of the most popular programs on Spotify -- that focuses on advice and issues affecting women.

Addressing reproductive issues and abortion -- which Democrats view as major vote winners among undecided voters -- Harris took particular exception to Trump's repeated insistence that he is a "protector" of women's rights.

"This is the same guy who said that women should be punished for having abortions," she said.

At one point Harris was asked how she felt when she heard Trump, in their presidential debate last month, say that some Democratic states allow the "execution" of babies after birth. In an impassioned reply, Harris denounced that as "a bold-faced lie," something "outrageously inaccurate" and "insulting to women."

"This guy," she added, "is full of lies."

BILATERAL TALKS IN NEW DELHI

Modi, Muizzu promise to strengthen cooperation

India, Maldives ink currency swap agreement

Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Maldives President Mohamed Muizzu held talks yesterday, with New Delhi promising to strengthen strategic cooperation as the island nation recovers from an economic crisis.

India approved a \$400 million and a 30 billion rupee (\$357.35 million) currency swap agreement, Modi said, adding that India was willing to provide extensive help to the Maldives to develop infrastructure.

Concerns have grown in recent months that cash-strapped Maldives could become the first

country to default on Islamic sovereign debt but sentiment has improved since China and India, which vie for influence in the strategically located archipelago, extended fresh support lines.

India extended emergency financial support to the Maldives last month by subscribing to its \$50 million treasury bill at the request

of Muizzu's government, days after China agreed to strengthen trade and investment in the Indian Ocean nation.

India and the Maldives will start talks on a free trade agreement, Modi and Muizzu said.

"We will work together for stability and progress in the Indian Ocean region," Modi said after the bilateral talks concluded. Muizzu is on a five-day state visit to India.

Much of the money the Maldives owes is to China and India, which have extended \$1.37 billion and \$124 million in loans respectively, according to World Bank Data. The fear of Maldives' default follows a

turbulent few years, as Covid-19 hammered the nation's mainstay tourism industry.

Maldives-India relations were hurt after Muizzu won power in April and demanded New Delhi replace 80 defence personnel it had stationed on the Maldives with civilians as part of his "India out" campaign. But the relationship has been on the mend following diplomatic talks and meetings since.

"India is a key partner in the socio-economic and infrastructure development of the Maldives and has stood by the Maldives during our times of need," Muizzu said.

Hezbollah rockets hit Haifa, Tiberias
Hamas fires missiles at Tel Aviv on invasion anniv

Hezbollah fired rockets at Israel's third largest city Haifa yesterday as Israeli forces looked poised to expand ground raids into south Lebanon on the first anniversary of the Gaza offensive, which has spread conflict across the Middle East.

Iran-backed Hezbollah, an ally of Hamas, the Palestinian group fighting Israel in Gaza, said it targeted a military base south of Haifa with "Fadi 1" missiles and launched another attack on Tiberias, 65 km (40 miles) away.

The spiralling conflict has raised concerns that the United States, Israel's superpower ally, and Iran will be sucked into a wider war in the oil-producing Middle East.

An Israeli military statement said five rockets were launched at Haifa from Lebanon and interceptors were fired at them. It said 15 other rockets were fired inland at Tiberias in Israel's northern Galilee region, some of which were shot down. Israel media said a further five rockets hit the Tiberias area.

Police said some buildings and properties were damaged, and there were reports of minor injuries, with some people taken to a nearby hospital. A surface-to-surface missile fired from Yemen at central Israel yesterday was intercepted, the Israeli military said.

Hamas also targeted Israel's commercial capital Tel Aviv with a missile salvo, the group said, setting off sirens in central areas of the country.

Turkey's President Recep Tayyip Erdogan vowed that Israel would pay a price for the "genocide" in Gaza as he marked the first anniversary of the Israeli offensive in Gaza.

Meanwhile, the Israeli military said the air force was carrying out extensive bombings of Hezbollah targets in south Lebanon, and that two Israeli soldiers were killed in border-area combat, taking the military death toll inside Lebanon so far to 11.
