ATAB calls for reform in travel sector

STAR REPORT

The Association of Travel Agents of Bangladesh (ATAB) today called for a reform in the travel sector, aimed at addressing alleged irregularities with a focus on reducing air fares and ensuring discipline.

ATAB also placed a 9-point demand aimed at addressing the challenges faced by the industry.

"There must be a guideline for group air ticketing to check hoarding and syndication in air ticket sales," said ATAB President Abdus Salam Aref at a press briefing.

The ATAB president raised concerns about the rising cost of air tickets, which he said is partly due to ticket hoarding under the guise of group bookings.

Aref alleged that certain airlines, in collaboration with

certain agents, are manipulating the system. He claimed that many individuals are selling tickets without being registered with the Civil Aviation Authority of Bangladesh. ATAB's 9-point demand includes formulation of proper regulations for online travel agencies, ending hoarding and syndication in air ticket sales, and making it mandatory for ticket information to include the agency's name, contact number, and price.
